Viola Frey She lived and worked in the San Francisco Bay Area and was renowned for her larger-than-life, colorfully glazed clay sculptures of men and women, which expanded the traditional boundaries of ceramic sculpture. Her paintings and pastel drawings reflect her love of the human figure, her colorful palette, and iconography similar to that used Viola Frey (August 15, 1933 – July 26, 2004) was an American artist working in sculpture, painting and drawing, and professor emerita at California College of the Arts. been widely exhibited 426b96362e

The painting includes many techniques characteristic of Degas's work and the Impressionist movement. Degas often painted his subjects from unconventional angles. The woman seated at the table is painted from a uniquely elevated angle that positions the viewer above her. Degas often used Impressionist techniques like abrupt cropping and asymmetrical composition as well. The composition of the painting is structured so that the hats take up more space than the subject at the table, giving the work a sense of spatial imbalance. Degas, like many other Impressionists, was interested in capturing images of urban modern life through the fleeting moments of the everyday. His choice to depict... 426b96362e The process typically begins with a determination that an aesthetically interesting barrier is needed. Then concept drawings are made by the design team and presented for approval. Once the design is accepted by the surrounding neighborhood and building team, the drawings evolve into sculptured creations. The sculptor can create the original work using a variety of mediums, such as clay, polyurethane and wax. Third stream In 1961, Schuller defined third stream as "a new genre of music Third stream is a music genre that is a fusion of jazz and classical music. Improvisation is generally seen as a vital component of third stream. It could refer to a group of jazz musicians playing solely, or a jazz soloist performing with a symphony orchestra, as long as the musicians are able to interpret and play jazz music. The term was coined in 1957 by composer Gunther Schuller in a lecture at Brandeis University. classical music and introduced a new genre that blends the two styles into a unique hybrid form. There are many ways to define third-stream music. " The innovative idea of fusing jazz and classical music pushed the boundaries of traditional classical music and introduced a new genre that blends the two styles into a unique hybrid form. The fusion of jazz and classical music is also viewed as "born out of a reciprocal interest: the interest of the classical community in the developments in jazz music and the interest of the jazz community in the advances of classical music. In third-stream music, composers incorporate elements of classical music, such as the use of classical instruments and classical music forms, into their jazz compositions 426b96362e
