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The quality of wine that gives
it its crispiness and vitality.
A proper balance of acidity must
be struck with the other
elements of a wine, or else the
wine may be said to be too sharp
– having disproportionately high
levels of acidity – or too flat
– having disproportionately low
levels of acidity. The three
main acids found in wine are

tartaric acid, malic acid and lactic acid. sagar "apple" and ardo "wine";, yielding sagardo or "cider"; and the suffix -tegi which denotes a building where A sagardotegi (pronounced [sagardo'tegi]) is a type of cider house found in the Basque Country where Basque cider and traditional foods such as cod omelettes are served. Modern sagardotegis can broadly be described as a cross between a steakhouse and a cider house

Cereals remained the most important staple during the Early Middle Ages as rice was introduced to Europe late, with the potato first used in the 16th century, and much later for the wider population. Barley, oats, and rye were eaten by the poor while wheat was generally more expensive. These were consumed as bread, porridge, gruel, and pasta by people of all classes. Cheese, fruits, and vegetables

were important supplements for the lower orders while meat was more expensive and generally more prestigious. Game, a form of meat acquired from hunting, was common only on the nobility's tables. The most prevalent butcher's meats were pork, chicken, and other poultry. Beef, which required greater investment in land, was less common. Measured using the pH scale. 29blcecaad Some traditional meals, such as bread and cheese, roasted and stewed meats, meat and game pies, boiled vegetables and broths with herbs or spices, and freshwater and saltwater fish have ancient origins. The 14th-century English cookbook, the *Forme of Cury*, contains recipes for these, and dates from the royal court of Richard II. 29blcecaad English cooking has been influenced by foreign ingredients and cooking styles since the Middle Ages. Curry was introduced from the Indian subcontinent and adapted to English tastes from the eighteenth century with Hannah Glasse's recipe for chicken "currey".
