Pinkerton (album) Weezer spent two weeks at New York City's Electric Lady Studios, where they had recorded their debut, and tracked the songs "Why Bother.", "Getchoo" Pinkerton is the second studio album by the American rock band Weezer, released on September 24, 1996, by DGC Records. The guitarist and vocalist Rivers Cuomo wrote most of Pinkerton while studying at Harvard University, after abandoning plans for a rock opera, *Songs from the Black Hole*. It was the last Weezer album to feature the bassist Matt Sharp, who left in 1998

Maybe You've Been Brainwashed Too Released on October 20, 1998, it was at the time their only album release before disbanding in 1999. best way to get the message across.
