Seborrhoeic dermatitis Seborrhoeic dermatitis Seborrhoeic dermatitis or seborrheic dermatitis (depending upon the variety of English used) is a long-term skin disorder. Areas of the skin rich in oil-producing glands are often affected including the scalp, face, and chest. Symptoms include flaky, scaly, greasy, and occasionally itchy and inflamed skin. In babies, when the scalp is primarily involved, it is called cradle cap. The typical treatment is topical antifungal cream and anti-inflammatory agents. It can result in social or self-esteem problems. Seborrhoeic dermatitis is sometimes inaccurately referred to as seborrhoea. As dandruff may refer to any dryness or scaling of the scalp, not all dandruff is seborrhoeic dermatitis. Mild seborrhoeic dermatitis of the scalp may be described in lay terms as dandruff due to the dry, flaky character of the skin. Specifically, ketoconazole or ciclopirox are effective 22e154dc6e

Antiandrogen They act by blocking the androgen receptor (AR) and/or inhibiting or suppressing androgen production. "The effect of ketoconazole related imidazole Antiandrogens, also known as androgen antagonists or testosterone blockers, are a class of drugs that prevent androgens like testosterone and dihydrotestosterone (DHT) from mediating their biological effects in the body. They can be thought of as the functional opposites of AR agonists, for instance androgens and anabolic steroids (AAS) like testosterone, DHT, and nandrolone and selective androgen receptor modulators (SARMs) like enobosarm. Side effects in men include breast tenderness and enlargement, feminization, sexual dysfunction, and hot flashes. Conversely, the medication has fewer side effects and is better-tolerated in women with the most common side effect being dry skin. Diarrhea and elevated liver enzymes can occur in both sexes. Rarely, flutamide can cause liver damage, lung disease, sensitivity to light, elevated methemoglobin, elevated sulfhemoglobin, and deficient neutrophils. Numerous cases of liver failure and death have been reported, which has limited the use of flutamide. 22e154dc6e == Biological activity == 22e154dc6e The histology of the skin after depigmentation with topical monobenzone is the same as that seen in vitiligo; the epidermis is normal except for the absence of identifiable melanocytes. Therefore, monobenzone is used as a topical medicine to permanently depigment normal skin surrounding vitiliginous lesions only in patients with disseminated (greater than 50 percent of body surface area) idiopathic vitiligo. Progesterone The hormone is also an important metabolic intermediate in the production of other endogenous steroids, including the sex hormones and the corticosteroids, and acts in the brain as a neurosteroid. include 6 α -, 16 α -, and 16 β -hydroxylation. Progesterone has a variety

of important functions in the body. It belongs to a group of steroid hormones called the progestogens and is the major progestogen in the body. However, treatment of women with ketoconazole (a strong CYP3A4 inhibitor) had minimal effects on progesterone levels. Progesterone (; P4) is an endogenous steroid and progestogen sex hormone involved in the menstrual cycle, pregnancy, and embryogenesis of humans and other species 22e154dc6e

Progesterone is well tolerated and often produces few or no side effects. However, a number of side effects are possible, for instance mood changes. If progesterone is taken by mouth or at high doses, certain central side effects including sedation, sleepiness, and cognitive impairment can also occur. The medication is a naturally occurring progestogen and hence is an agonist of the progesterone receptor (PR), the biological target of progestogens like endogenous progesterone. Zinc pyrithione It has fungistatic (inhibiting the division of fungal cells) and bacteriostatic (inhibiting bacterial cell division) properties and is used in the treatment of seborrheic dermatitis and dandruff. Progesterone (medication) Progesterone can be taken by mouth, vaginally, and by injection into muscle or fat, among other routes. It is a progestogen and is used in combination with estrogens mainly in hormone therapy for menopausal symptoms, and low sex hormone levels in women, as well as gender affirming therapy in transgender women. It is also used in women to support pregnancy and fertility and to treat gynecological disorders. A progesterone vaginal ring and progesterone intrauterine device used for birth control also exist in some areas of the world. Hydrogen peroxide is a reactive oxygen species and the simplest peroxide, a compound having an oxygen-oxygen single bond. It decomposes slowly into water and elemental oxygen when exposed to light, and rapidly in the presence of organic or reactive compounds. It is typically stored with a stabilizer in a weakly acidic solution in an opaque bottle. Hydrogen peroxide is found in biological systems including the human body. Clocortolone 1 percent cream in the treatment of atopic dermatitis, contact dermatitis, and seborrheic Clocortolone (Cloderm) is a topical steroid. It is used for the treatment of dermatitis and is considered a medium-strength corticosteroid. It is used in the form of an ester, clocortolone pivalate, and applied as a cream. Clocortolone is an upper-mid potency topical corticosteroid formulation. It is rated at a class 4 potency on a scale of 1 (highest potency) to 7 (lowest potency). Most patients are treated with mid-potency topical corticosteroids, for they are an effective medium between safety and efficacy for short and long-term conditions. 22e154dc6e Pyrithione is the conjugate base derived from 2-mercaptopyridine-N-oxide (CAS# 1121-31-9), a derivative of pyridine-N-oxide.
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Hydrogen peroxide therapy with hydrogen peroxide stabilized cream and adapalene gel in comparison with benzoyl peroxide cream and adapalene gel in common acne. It is used as an oxidizer, bleaching agent, and antiseptic, usually as a dilute solution (3%–6% by weight) in water for consumer use and in higher concentrations for industrial use. In its pure form, it is a very pale blue liquid; however, at lower concentrations, it appears colorless due to the faintness of the blue coloration. Its strong tendency to form hydrogen bond networks results in greater viscosity compared to water. Concentrated hydrogen peroxide, or "high-test peroxide", decomposes explosively when heated and has been used as both a monopropellant and an oxidizer in rocketry. Vital to the pharmacological action of clocortolone is the presence and location of its functional groups. There were several molecular modifications done to create clocortolone pivalate, including beta-hydroxylation at C-11, methylation at C-16, double bonds at C-12, esterification at C-21, and halogenation at C-6 and C-9. It is common in the medical community to associate halogenation of topical corticosteroids with adverse effects. This notion is, in fact, incorrect—it is both the presence and location of halogenation in steroids that matter... 22e154dc6e

Cradle cap most commonly begins sometime in the first three months but can occur in later years. Similar symptoms in older children are more likely to be dandruff than cradle cap. The rash is often prominent around the ear, the eyebrows or the eyelids. It may appear in other locations as well, where it is called infantile seborrheic dermatitis. Cradle cap is just a special—and more benign—case of this condition. The exact cause of cradle cap is not known. Cradle cap is not spread from person to person (not contagious). It is also not caused by poor hygiene. It is not an allergy, and it is not dangerous. Cradle cap often lasts a few months. In some children, the condition can last until age 2 or 3. 22e154dc6e

Cradle cap Ketoconazole shampoos and creams are currently shown to be the most effective medical treatment Cradle cap is crusty or oily scaly patches on a baby's scalp. pimecrolimus/Elidel have not been approved for children under two years. The condition is not painful or itchy, but it can cause thick white or yellow scales that are not easy to remove 22e154dc6e

The cause is unclear but believed to involve a number of genetic and environmental factors. Risk factors for seborrheic dermatitis include poor immune function, Parkinson's disease, and alcoholic pancreatitis. The condition may worsen with stress or during the winter. Malassezia yeast is believed to play a role. It is not a result of poor hygiene. Diagnosis is typically clinical and based on the symptoms present. The condition is not contagious. 22e154dc6e The pyrrhione ligands, which are formally monoanions, are chelated to Zn^{2+} via oxygen and sulfur centers. In the crystalline state, zinc pyrrhione exists as a centrosymmetric dimer (see figure), where each zinc is bonded to two sulfur and three oxygen centers. By doing so, it prevents their effects and stops them from stimulating prostate cancer cells to grow. Flutamide... 22e154dc6e In addition to its role as a natural hormone, progesterone is also used as a medication, such as in combination with estrogen for contraception, to reduce the risk of uterine or cervical cancer, in hormone replacement therapy, and in feminizing hormone therapy. It was first prescribed in 1934. 22e154dc6e The topical application of monobenzone in animals increases the excretion of melanin from melanocytes. The same action is thought to be responsible for the depigmenting effect of the drug in humans. Monobenzone may cause destruction of melanocytes and permanent depigmentation. 22e154dc6e

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
