They fully manage payment processing and external network relationships, making the merchant less dependent on banking institutions. It is a black box for its consumers, meaning the consumer does not have to be aware of the service's inner workings. They will often provide merchant services and act as a payment gateway or payment processor for e-commerce and brick and mortar businesses. They may also offer risk management services for card and bank based payments, transaction payment matching, digital wallets, reporting, fund remittance, currency exchange and fraud protection. The PSP will typically provide software to integrate with e-commerce websites or point of sale systems. Another common form of hosting service is shared hosting, where the hosting provider provisions hosting services for multiple clients on one physical server and shares the resources between the clients. Virtualization is necessary to make it work effectively.

Internet hosting service A common kind of hosting is web hosting, the Internet. Most hosting providers offer a combination of services - e-mail hosting, website hosting, and database. An Internet hosting service is a service that runs servers connected to the Internet, allowing organizations and individuals to serve content or host services connected to the Internet.

Dedicated server hosts provide a server, usually housed in a datacenter and connected to the Internet where clients can run anything they want (including web servers and other servers). The hosting provider ensures that the servers have Internet connections with good upstream bandwidth and reliable power sources.

PaaS can be delivered in three ways:

Backend as a service Some of the most popular service providers are AWS Amplify and Firebase. The providers offer the unlimited API calls inside their free plan offerings. Another business model that has been used by a lot of BaaS providers is PAYG. Backend as a service (BaaS), sometimes also referred to as mobile backend as a service (MBaaS), is a service for providing web app and mobile app developers with a way to easily build a backend to their frontend applications. These services are provided via the use of custom software development kits (SDKs) and application programming interfaces (APIs). BaaS is a relatively recent development in cloud computing, with most BaaS startups dating from 2011 or later. Features available include user management, push notifications, and integration with social networking services.
