Therefore, symptoms generally Cold agglutinin disease (CAD) is a rare autoimmune disease characterized by the presence of high concentrations of circulating cold sensitive antibodies, usually IgM and autoantibodies that are also active at temperatures below 30 °C (86 °F), directed against red blood cells, causing them to agglutinate and undergo lysis. Symptoms of cold agglutinin disease (CAD) are often triggered or made worse by cold temperatures or a viral infection. It is a form of autoimmune hemolytic anemia,

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specifically one in which antibodies bind red blood cells only at low body temperatures, typically 28–31 °C 33d577f9f1

Cold agglutinin-mediated acrocyanosis differs from Raynaud phenomenon. In Raynaud phenomena, caused by vasospasm, a triphasic color change occurs, from white to blue to red, based on vasculature response. No evidence of such a response exists in cold agglutinin disease. 33d577f9f1 The cause is usually herpes simplex virus type 1 (HSV-1) and occasionally herpes simplex virus type 2 (HSV-2). The infection is typically spread between people by direct non-sexual contact. Attacks can be triggered by sunlight, fever, psychological stress, or a menstrual period. Direct contact with the genitals can result in genital herpes. Diagnosis is

== Presentation == 33d577f9f1 Freezing cold skin injuries include frostbite and frostnip. These injuries often affect the fingers, toes, nose, and ears since they are less commonly covered by clothing when in cold environments. Affected skin becomes numb, turns white or blue, and develops blisters. Frostnip is a superficial skin injury that won't freeze the skin or cause long-term damage. Cold urticaria Hives vary in size from about 7 mm in diameter to as big as about 27 mm or larger. The hives are usually itchy and often the hands, feet and other parts of the body will become itchy and swollen as well. Cold injury While these injuries have disproportionately affected military members, recreational winter activities have also increased the risk and incidence within civilian populations. Freezing cold injuries involve tissue damage when exposed to temperatures below freezing (less than 0 degrees Celsius). Additional risk factors include homelessness, inadequate or wet clothing, alcohol abuse or tobacco abuse, and pre-existing medical conditions that impair blood flow. Nonfreezing cold injuries involve tissue damage when exposed to temperatures often between 0-15 degrees Celsius for extended periods of time. Common cold symptoms are mostly due to the body's immune response to the infection rather than to tissue destruction by the viruses themselves. People usually recover in seven to ten days, but some symptoms may last up to three weeks. Signs and symptoms may appear in as little as two days after exposure to the virus. Occasionally, those with other health problems may develop pneumonia. These may include coughing, sore throat, runny nose, sneezing, headache, fatigue, and fever. Cold-stimulus headache The rate of intake for cold foods has been studied as a contributing factor. When affected people's blood is exposed to cold temperatures (32 °F (0 °C; 273 K) to 50 °F (10 °C; 283 K)), certain proteins that normally attack bacteria (IgM antibodies) attach themselves to red blood cells and bind them together into clumps (agglutination). This eventually causes red blood cells to be prematurely destroyed (hemolysis) leading to anemia and other associated signs and symptoms. 33d577f9f1 A sign, for example, can be an elevated or lower than normal temperature or blood pressure, or an abnormal finding showing on medical imaging.
