Rare-earths are to be distinguished from critical minerals, which are materials of strategic or economic importance that are defined differently by different countries, and rare-earth minerals, which are minerals that contain one or more rare-earth elements as major metal constituents. Compounds containing rare-earth elements have diverse applications in electrical and electronic components, lasers, glass, magnetic materials, and industrial processes. The adjective "rare" may also mean strange or extraordinary. The 15 lanthanides (or lanthanoids), along with scandium, and yttrium, are usually included as rare earths

Chemical element The number of protons is called the atomic number of that element. Almost all baryonic matter in the universe is composed of elements (among rare exceptions are neutron stars). universe is composed of elements (among rare exceptions are neutron stars). Atoms of one element can be transformed into atoms of a different element in nuclear reactions, which change an atom's atomic number. For example, oxygen has an atomic number of 8: each oxygen atom has 8 protons in its nucleus. Atoms of the same element can have different numbers of neutrons in their nuclei, known as isotopes of the element. procedures. agreements among Sudanese political and military forces for a democratic transition in Sudan began in July 2019. Omar al-Bashir overthrew the democratically elected government of Sadiq al-Mahdi in 1989 and was himself overthrown in the 2019 Sudanese coup d'état, in which he was replaced by the Transitional Military Council (TMC) after months of sustained street protests

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
