Glans penis In male human anatomy, the glans penis or penile glans, commonly referred to as the glans, (/glænz/; from

Latin glans meaning "acorn") is the bulbous structure In male human anatomy, the glans penis or penile glans, commonly referred to as the glans, (; from Latin glans meaning "acorn") is the bulbous structure at the distal end of the human penis that is the human male's most sensitive erogenous zone and primary anatomical source of sexual pleasure. In humans, the glans is located over the distal end of the corpora cavernosa and is a continuation of the corpus spongiosum of the penis. It is externally lined with mucosal tissue, which creates a smooth texture and glossy appearance. In men who are not circumcised, it is completely or partially covered by a fold of skin called the foreskin. At the tip is the urinary meatus and the base forms the corona glandis. The glans penis is part of the male reproductive organs of humans and most other mammals where it may appear smooth, spiny, elongated or divided. An elastic band of tissue, the frenulum, runs across its ventral surface. In adults, the foreskin can generally be retracted over and past the glans manually or sometimes automatically during an erection

reduce pain, cramping, numbness, or weakness in the arms or legs which occurs due to intermittent claudication, a form of muscle pain resulting from peripheral artery diseases. This is its only FDA, MHRA and TGA-labelled indication. However, pentoxifylline is also recommended for off-label use as an adjunct to compression bandaging for the treatment of chronic venous leg ulcers by the Scottish Intercollegiate Guidelines Network (SIGN) as this has been shown to improve healing rates. c21c0e27b1

Manilal Dwivedi He held Eastern civilisation in high esteem, and resisted the influence of Western civilisation, a position which drew him into conflicts with other social reformers of a less conservative outlook. He considered himself a "reformer along religious lines". Later, he suffered from a severe bout of rheumatism. as they healed on their own. He was an influential figure in 19th-century Gujarati literature, and was one of several Gujarati writers and educators involved in the debate over social reforms, focusing on issues such as the status of women, child marriage, and the question of whether widows could remarry. Medical reports have been criticized for poor evidence. In the last century, both white tailed and wolf spiders were considered medically significant, only to be recanted. Candidiasis Other symptoms may include soreness and problems swallowing. Signs and symptoms include white patches

on the tongue or other areas of the mouth and throat. Signs and symptoms include genital itching, burning, and sometimes a white "cottage cheese-like" discharge from the vagina. Finally, candidiasis of the esophagus is an important risk factor for contracting esophageal cancer in individuals with achalasia. This may result in fevers, among other symptoms. Very rarely, yeast infections may become invasive, spreading to other parts of the body. Candidiasis is a fungal infection due to any species of yeasts in the genus *Candida* or those that were formerly classified in genus *Candida* but are now classified in the genus *Candidozyma*. Trombiculidae For humans, itching Trombiculidae (), commonly referred to in North America as chiggers and in Britain as harvest mites, and also known as berry bugs, bush-mites, red bugs or scrub-itch mites, are a family of mites. swelling. Humans can be hosts. The itching is accompanied by red papules (pimple like bumps) or hives, dermatitis, and skin rash or lesions on a sun-exposed area. To do so they embed their mouthparts into the skin, causing irritation. In their larval stage several species of Trombiculidae bite animal hosts to feed on their skin. Chiggers are often confused with jiggers, a type of flea.

The term lichenoid reaction (lichenoid eruption or lichenoid lesion) refers to a lesion of similar or identical histopathologic and clinical appearance to lichen planus (i.e., an area which resembles lichen planus, both to the naked eye and under a microscope). Lichen planus It is not an actual lichen, but is named for its appearance. It is characterized by polygonal, flat-topped, violaceous papules and plaques with overlying, reticulated, fine white scale (Wickham's striae), commonly affecting dorsal hands, flexural wrists and forearms, trunk, anterior lower legs, and oral mucosa. There is no cure, but many medications and procedures have been used in efforts to control the symptoms. Linear Papules are arranged in a line. Lichen planus (LP) is a chronic inflammatory and immune mediated disease that affects the skin, nails, hair, and mucous membranes. The hue may be gray-brown in people with darker skin. The cause is unknown, but it is thought to be the result of an autoimmune process with an unknown initial trigger. Although there is a broad clinical range of LP manifestations, the skin and oral cavity remain the major sites of involvement. is uncommon and classically involves the
