Today, most of the world prefers metric measurement by weight, though the preference for volume measurements continues among home cooks in the United States and the rest of North America. Different ingredients are measured in different ways: For most of history, most cookbooks did not specify quantities precisely, instead talking of "a nice leg of spring lamb", a "cupful" of lentils, a piece of butter "the size of a small apricot", and "sufficient" salt. Informal measurements such as a "pinch", a "drop", or a "hint" (suspçon) continue to be used from time to time. In the US, Fannie Farmer introduced the more exact specification of quantities by volume in her 1896 Boston Cooking-School Cook Book. Dry bulk ingredients, such as sugar and flour, are measured by weight in most of the world ("250 g flour"), and by volume in North America ("1/2 cup flour"). Small quantities of salt and spices are generally measured by volume worldwide, as few households have sufficiently precise balances to measure by weight.

Health effects of wine Practically no authorities recommend starting to drink wine for positive health effects. Some experts define "moderate consumption" as less than one 5-US-fluid-ounce (150 ml) glass of wine per day for The health effects of wine are mainly determined by its active ingredient – alcohol. Other studies found no such effects and medical consensus tends towards there being no positive effects from drinking apart from positive social effects if kept in strict moderation. lower than those for a male of equal age. Preliminary studies found that drinking small quantities of wine (up to one standard drink per day for women and one to two drinks per day for men), particularly of red wine, may be associated with a decreased risk of cardiovascular diseases, cognitive decline, stroke, diabetes mellitus, metabolic syndrome, and early death

Drinking more than the standard drink amount increases the risk of cardiovascular diseases, high blood pressure, atrial fibrillation, stroke, and cancer. Mixed results are also observed in light drinking and cancer mortality. Risk is greater in young people due to binge drinking, which may result in violence or accidents. About 88,000 deaths in the United States are estimated to be due to alcohol each year. Alcoholism reduces a person's life expectancy by around ten years and excessive

alcohol use is the third leading... In 2008, within an alcoholic beverage market worth some A\$16.3 billion, equivalent to A\$22.6 billion in 2022, beer comprised about 48% compared to wine at 29% and spirits at 21%. Within the beer sector, premium beers had a 7.8% share of the market; full-strength beer 70.6%; mid-strength 12%; and light beer 9.6%. Overall, 85% of beer was produced by national brewers, the remainder by regional or microbreweries. Microbreweries manufacturing less than 30,000 litres (7,900 US gal) received a 60% excise rebate. == Metrication == The US Customary system of units was developed and used in the United States after the American Revolution, based on a subset of the English units used in the Thirteen Colonies. It is the predominant system of units in the United States and its territories, except for Puerto Rico and Guam, where the metric system was introduced under Spanish rule and remains prevalent. The imperial system of units was developed and used in the United Kingdom and its empire beginning in 1824. The metric system has, to varying degrees, replaced the imperial system in the countries that once used it.
