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Humans, like most other mammals, are diphyodont, meaning that they develop two sets of teeth. The first set, deciduous teeth, also called "primary teeth", "baby teeth", or "milk teeth", normally eventually contains 20 teeth.

Primary teeth typically start to appear ("erupt") around six months of age and this may be distracting and/or painful for the infant. However, some babies are born with one or more visible teeth, known as neonatal teeth or "natal teeth". 336a77f6e2 == Theories == 336a77f6e2 ==

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Hypodontia ages 6 to 14, with the exception of the third molar, also known as the wisdom teeth which normally erupt between 17 and 25 years of age. If the tooth has Hypodontia is defined as the developmental absence of one or more teeth excluding the third molars. It rarely occurs in primary teeth (also known as deciduous, milk, first and baby teeth) and the most commonly affected are the adult second premolars and the upper lateral incisors. It is one of the most common dental anomalies, and can have a negative impact on function, and also appearance. It usually occurs as part of a syndrome that involves other abnormalities and requires multidisciplinary treatment

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Today, humans possess 32 permanent teeth with a dental formula of 2.1.2.32.1.2.3. This breaks down to two pairs of incisors, one pair of canines, two pairs of premolars, and three pairs of molars on each jaw. In modern day humans, incisors are generally spatulate with a single root while canines are also single rooted but are single cusped and conical. Premolars are bicuspid while molars are multi-cuspid. Charles Darwin listed a number of putative human vestigial features, which he termed rudimentary, in *The Descent of Man* (1871). Darwin also commented on the sporadic nature of many vestigial features, particularly musculature. Making reference to the work of the anatomist William Turner, Darwin highlighted a number of sporadic muscles that he identified as vestigial remnants of the panniculus carnosus, particularly the

Human tooth Humans have four types of teeth: incisors, canines, premolars, and molars, which each have a specific function. The incisors cut the food, the canines tear the food and the molars and premolars crush the food. [citation needed] When they do form Human teeth function to mechanically break down items of food by cutting and crushing them in preparation for swallowing and digesting. Teeth are made of multiple tissues of varying density and hardness. These molars may never erupt into the mouth or form at all. called "wisdom teeth" and usually emerge at ages 17 to 25. The roots of teeth are embedded in the maxilla (upper jaw) or the mandible (lower jaw) and are covered by gums. As such, they are considered part of the human digestive system 336a77f6e2

Tooth eruption The first human teeth to appear, the deciduous (primary) teeth (also known as baby or milk teeth), erupt into the mouth from around 6 months until 2

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years of age, in a process known as "teething". These teeth are the only ones in the mouth until a person is about 6 years old, creating the primary dentition stage. In tooth eruption. It is currently believed that the periodontal ligament plays an important role in tooth eruption. The first human teeth to appear, the deciduous (primary) teeth (also known as baby or milk teeth), erupt into the mouth from around Tooth eruption is a process in tooth development in which the teeth enter the mouth and become visible. Then, the remaining permanent teeth erupt into the mouth during the permanent dentition stage. At that time, the first permanent tooth erupts and begins a period in which there is a combination of primary and permanent teeth, known as the mixed dentition stage, which lasts until the last primary tooth is lost 336a77f6e2

Hypodontia: one to six missing teeth excluding the third molars 336a77f6e2 There are two main types of bruxism: one occurs during sleep (nocturnal bruxism) and one during wakefulness (awake bruxism).
