Perphenazine Chemically, it is classified as a piperazinylophenothiazine. Fixed combinations of perphenazine and the tricyclic antidepressant amitriptyline in different proportions of weight exist. Citalopram It is used to treat major depressive disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, panic disorder, and social anxiety disorder. It is typically taken orally (swallowed by mouth). Methylphenidate, sold under the brand names Ritalin and Concerta, among others, is a central nervous system (CNS) stimulant used primarily in the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and narcolepsy. Though pharmaceuticals can be injected into the nose, some concerns include injuries, infection, and safe disposal. Studies demonstrate improved patient compliance with inhalation. Delivering a thermoresponsive hydrogel loaded with berberine intranasally exhibited high bioavailability in hippocampus and antidepressant. Intranasal drug delivery occurs when particles are inhaled into the nasal cavity and transported directly into the nervous system. Intranasal administration is a potential route associated with high drug transfer from nose to brain and drug bioavailability. Previous studies evaluated the efficacy of delivery therapeutics through intranasal route for brain diseases and mental health conditions bd436871d5

Its mechanism of action is not entirely clear but is believed to be related to its ability as a dopamine antagonist. Opipramol depression. Unlike other TCAs, opipramol does not inhibit the reuptake of serotonin or norepinephrine. However, it does act as a high affinity antagonist of Opipramol, sold under the brand name Insidon among others, is an anxiolytic and tricyclic antidepressant that is used throughout Europe. Despite chemically being a tricyclic dibenzazepine (iminostilbene) derivative similar to imipramine, opipramol is not a monoamine reuptake inhibitor like most other tricyclic antidepressants, and instead acts primarily as a sigma-1 receptor agonist. The first drug delivery system is often dated to the 1950s, when Smith Kline & French Laboratories introduced the Spansule technology. Between 1950s and 1980s, there were four drug release systems developed for oral and transdermal applications: dissolution, diffusion, osmosis, and ion-exchange controlled release. Bupropion Bupropion has several features that distinguish it from other antidepressants: it does not usually cause sexual dysfunction, it is not associated with weight gain or sleepiness, and it is more effective than SSRIs at improving symptoms of hypersomnia and fatigue. The medication is taken by mouth. Bupropion, particularly the immediate-release formulation, carries a higher risk of seizure than many other antidepressants; hence, caution is recommended in patients with a history of seizure disorder. It is a norepinephrine-dopamine reuptake inhibitor (NDRI). Some evidence-based guidelines support first-line use. Methylphenidate reduces core ADHD symptoms and is thought to do so primarily by increasing dopamine and norepinephrine activity in the brain. It may also improve aspects of executive functions, including working memory, sustained attention, and inhibitory

control. In clinical use, the effects are generally described as lasting for several hours, although individual response varies substantially between formulations and patients. It may also address certain fundamental features surrounding narcolepsy besides cataplexy (especially hypnagogic and hypnopompic hallucinations). The evidence behind this, however, is less robust. As with other antidepressants (notably including selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors), it may paradoxically increase the risk of suicide in those under the age of 25, at least in the first few weeks of treatment. Perphenazine is roughly ten times as potent as chlorpromazine at the dopamine-2 (D2) receptor; thus perphenazine is considered a medium-potency antipsychotic. In addition to its role as a natural hormone, progesterone is also used as a medication, such as in combination with estrogen for contraception, to reduce the risk of uterine or cervical cancer, in hormone replacement therapy, and in feminizing hormone therapy. It was first prescribed in 1934.

Other uses include the treatment of bipolar disorder, severe behavioral problems in children including those with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, nausea and vomiting, anxiety before surgery, and hiccups that do not improve following other measures

== History == In low doses it is used to treat agitated depression (together with an antidepressant). Fixed combinations of perphenazine and the tricyclic antidepressant amitriptyline in different proportions of weight exist (see Etrafon below). When treating depression, perphenazine is discontinued as fast as the clinical situation allows. Perphenazine has no intrinsic antidepressive activity. Several studies show that the use of perphenazine with fluoxetine (Prozac) in patients with psychotic depression is most promising, although fluoxetine interferes with the metabolism of perphenazine, causing higher plasma levels of perphenazine and a longer half-life. In this combination the strong antiemetic action of perphenazine attenuates fluoxetine-induced nausea and vomiting (emesis), as well as the initial agitation caused by...
