The phrase "doctrine of the mean" occurs in Book VI, verse 29 of the Analects of Confucius, which states: Something is objective if it can be confirmed through observation, experimentation and intersubjective dialogue. This observation was subsequently investigated through rigorous experimentation, leading to objective evidence that established penicillin as an effective antibacterial agent.
