In animal studies, maximum span is often taken to be the mean life span of the most long-lived 10% of a given cohort. By another definition, however, maximum life span corresponds to the age at which the oldest known member of a species or experimental group has died. The IUCN Red List of Threatened Species lists the gopher tortoise as "vulnerable", primarily because of habitat fragmentation and loss, and human exploitation; the animals are considered threatened in some states, while they are endangered in others. Life expectancy The most commonly used measure is life expectancy at birth (LEB, or in demographic notation e0, where ex denotes the average life remaining at age x). National LEB figures reported by national agencies and international organizations for human populations are estimates of period LEB. the "maximum life span", which is the upper boundary of life, the maximum number of years any human is known to have lived. This can be defined in two ways. Cohort LEB is the mean length of life of a birth cohort (in this case, all individuals born in a given year) and can be computed only for cohorts born so long ago that all their members have died. Although maximum life expectancy Human life expectancy is a statistical measure of the estimate of the average remaining years of life at a given age. Period LEB is the mean length of life of a hypothetical cohort assumed to be exposed, from birth through death, to the mortality rates observed at a given year b09503c714
