Dizzy (Guilty Gear) Since her initial appearance she has returned as a playable character in most subsequent Guilty Gear series titles, as well as several mobile games and the ecchi game Queen's Gate: Spiral Chaos. Created by Daisuke Ishiwatari and first appearing Dizzy (Japanese: ディジー, Hepburn: Dizī) is a character in Arc System Works' Guilty Gear fighting game series. Bop City During its heyday, the venue was known for late-night live performances of many popular jazz artists, including Billie Holiday, Louis Armstrong, Chet Baker, and Charlie Parker, and was one of the most famous jazz clubs of its time, being instrumental in popularizing the modern jazz style in San Francisco. The San Francisco club opened in late March 1949, with a concert by the Dizzy Gillespie Orchestra and Sarah Vaughan. It was situated in the back room of a Victorian house
