Woburn Safari Park was opened in 1970, established by the 13th Duke of Bedford and Jimmy Chipperfield on the grounds of his estate, Woburn Abbey. This was done as a means to help improve the financial position of the estate and restore the Abbey, which had fallen into disrepair as a consequence of the Second World War and relatively high post-war tax rates. The 11th Duke of Bedford had been president of the Zoological Society of London and had introduced various species such as American bison, deer, antelope, lions and tigers to the park. 37088cb8b1

Since the 1980s, zoologists have studied the sexual behaviors of giant pandas, a then-endangered species. The giant panda is threatened by persistent habitat destruction and fragmentation. Additionally, giant pandas have low fertility rates, which do not increase when they are in captivity, and female pandas, who ovulate once a year, are only receptive to mating... 37088cb8b1 The giant panda lives exclusively in six montane regions in a few Chinese provinces at elevations of up to 3,000 m (9,800 ft). It is solitary and gathers only in mating seasons. It relies on olfactory communication to communicate and uses scent marks as chemical cues and on landmarks like rocks or trees. Females rear cubs for an average of 18 to 24 months. The oldest known giant panda was 38 years old. 37088cb8b1

Woburn Safari Park It is part of the estates of the Duke of Bedford that also includes Woburn Abbey and its 3,000-acre (1,200 ha) deer park. There is also a soft play centre called the Mammoth Play Woburn Safari Park is a safari park located in Woburn, Bedfordshire, England. The Safari Park itself covers 360 acres (150 ha). Giant panda Its body is rotund; adult individuals weigh 100 to 115 kg (220 to 254 lb) and are typically 1.2 to 1.8 m (3 ft 11 in to 6 ft 3 in) long. It can digest starch and is mostly herbivorous with a diet consisting almost entirely of bamboo and bamboo shoots. It is characterised by its white coat with black patches around the eyes, ears, legs and shoulders. It has large molar teeth and expanded temporal fossae to meet its dietary requirements. A thumb is visible on its forepaw, which helps in holding bamboo in place for feeding. The National Zoo has two campuses. The first is a 163-acre (66 ha) urban park located at Rock Creek Park in the Woodley Park neighborhood of Northwest Washington, D.C., 20 minutes from the National Mall by MetroRail. The other campus is the 3,200-acre (1,300 ha) Smithsonian Conservation Biology Institute (SCBI; formerly known as the Conservation and Research Center) in Front Royal, Virginia. On this land, there are 180 species of trees, 850 species of woody shrubs and herbaceous plants, 40 species of grasses, and 36 different species of bamboo. The SCBI is a non-public facility devoted to training wildlife professionals in conservation biology and to propagating rare species through natural means and assisted reproduction.
