== Etymology == Some common naturally occurring steroid hormones are cortisol (C₂₁H₃₀O₅), corticosterone (C₂₁H₃₀O₄), cortisone (C₂₁H₂₈O₅) and aldosterone (C₂₁H₂₈O₅) (cortisone and aldosterone are isomers). The main corticosteroids produced by the adrenal cortex are cortisol and aldosterone. Hydrocortisone... Weaker topical steroids are utilized for thin-skinned and sensitive areas, especially areas under occlusion, such as the armpit, groin, buttock crease, and breast folds. Weaker steroids are used on the face, eyelids, diaper area, perianal skin, and intertrigo of the groin or body folds. Moderate steroids are used for atopic dermatitis, nummular eczema, xerotic eczema, lichen sclerosis et atrophicus of the vulva, scabies (after scabicide) and severe dermatitis. Strong steroids are used for psoriasis, lichen planus, discoid... Hydrocortisone was patented in 1936 and approved for medical use in 1941. It is on the World Health Organization's List of Essential Medicines. It is available as a generic medication. In 2023, it was the 182nd most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than 2 million prescriptions. Hydrocortisone was discovered by Nobel laureates Edward C. Kendall and Philip S. Hench in the 1930s while they were conducting research on rheumatoid arthritis. Its topical use was first recorded in the 1950s. Topical hydrocortisone is indicated for relieving swelling, irritation and redness in a number of skin conditions, including insect bites, heat rash, eczema, psoriasis, contact dermatitis and nappy rash. It could be formulated as a single active ingredient in some medications, e.g. Cortaid, which is applied for anal itchiness.... The most common adverse effects after the application of topical hydrocortisone are burning and stinging sensations. Side effects after long-term usage include eyesight damage, elevated blood sugar levels and adrenal gland disorders. == Medical uses == The etymology of the cortico- part of the name refers to the adrenal cortex, which makes these steroid hormones. Thus a corticosteroid is a "cortex steroid".

It can be given by mouth, topically, rectally or by injection. Hydrocortisone is the name for the hormone cortisol when supplied as a medication. Uses include conditions such as adrenocortical insufficiency, adrenogenital syndrome, high blood calcium, thyroiditis, rheumatoid arthritis, dermatitis, asthma, and COPD. Stopping treatment after long-term use should be done slowly. Intermittent use of topical steroids for atopic dermatitis is safe and does not cause skin thinning. 09c1d27de6

Hydrocortisone/miconazole Hydrocortisone/miconazole is a combination drug, often consisting of 1% hydrocortisone (a topical steroid) with 2% miconazole (an antifungal). Hydrocortisone/miconazole is sold as Daktacort in the UK and Sweden, Daktodor in Greece, Cortimyk in

Sweden and Brentacort in Denmark. Hydrocortisone/miconazole Hydrocortisone/miconazole is a combination drug, often consisting of 1% hydrocortisone (a topical steroid) with 2% miconazole (an antifungal) 09c1d27de6

The combination was approved for medical use in the United States in 1964. In 2022, it was the 296th most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than 400,000 prescriptions. 09c1d27de6 Hydrocortisone aceponate is typically used for skin conditions in veterinary practices for dogs. In this instance, it can be used on acute otitis externa, a bacterial infection causing inflammation of the ear canal, as well as a treatment for itchy skin caused by allergies. Additionally, hydrocortisone aceponate can be used to treat hormonal disorders and immune and allergic disorders. The main use for hydrocortisone aceponate is for atopic skin conditions and acute ear infections. It is shown to help with skin lesions and inflammation that respond to corticosteroids but may have been resistant to other treatments. Corticosteroid The two main classes of corticosteroids – glucocorticoids and mineralocorticoids – are involved in a wide range of physiological processes, including stress response, immune response, and regulation of inflammation, carbohydrate metabolism, protein catabolism, blood electrolyte levels, and behavior. are often used in the screening of allergies to topical steroids. Hydrocortisone aceponate It is an ester of hydrocortisone (cortisol) with acetic acid and propionic acid. absorption Delayed wound healing Redness on skin Hydrocortisone aceponate is a steroid which takes the form of a diester. The diester increases transmission Hydrocortisone aceponate is a veterinary corticosteroid that is used in form of creams for the treatment of various dermatoses (skin conditions) 09c1d27de6

The most common side effects include itchiness and a skin rash. Other side effects may include dizziness, hives, anaphylaxis, hearing loss, and headache. Safety in pregnancy and breastfeeding is unclear. The antibiotics work by killing specific types of bacteria while the steroids work by decreasing inflammation. 09c1d27de6 Common side effects may include mood changes, increased appetite, hyperglycemia, hypertension, and edema (swelling). With long-term use, common side effects include osteoporosis, adrenal insufficiency, upset stomach, physical weakness, easy bruising, and candidiasis (yeast infections).
