Bed bug bites are caused primarily by two species of insects: Cimex lectularius (the common

bed bug) and *Cimex hemipterus*, found primarily in the tropics. Their size ranges between 1 and 7 mm. They spread by crawling between nearby locations or by being carried within personal items. Infestation is rarely due to a lack of hygiene but is more common in high-density areas. Diagnosis involves both finding the bugs and the occurrence of compatible symptoms.
