Chord (geometry) Ptolemy used a circle of diameter 120, and gave chord In geometry, a chord (from Latin chorda 'catgut, string') of a circle is a straight line segment whose endpoints both lie on a circular arc. If a chord were to be extended infinitely on both directions into a line, the object is a secant line. giving the value of the chord for angles ranging from 1/2 to 180 degrees by increments of 1/2 degree. The perpendicular line passing through the chord's midpoint is called sagitta (Latin for "arrow")
