This procedure is usually performed by a gynecologist. Endometrial ablation is typically used to address abnormal uterine bleeding, which can be a symptom of multiple health conditions. There are very limited surgical treatments to address abnormal uterine bleeding, the only other option being hysterectomy. This procedure can cause patients to experience permanent side effects and long-term complications. sometimes conducted after treatment with hormones, such as norethisterone or Lupron to reduce the thickness of the endometrium. This destruction causes the formation of scar tissue, preventing the endometrium from regrowing. It is estimated that around 500,000 patients undergo endometrial ablation procedures each year. Feminizing hormone therapy GnRH agonists, such as leuporelin (Lupron), goserelin (Zoladex), and buserelin (Suprefact) Feminizing hormone therapy, also known as transfeminine hormone therapy, is a form of gender-affirming care and a gender-affirming hormone therapy to change the primary and secondary sex characteristics of transgender people from masculine to feminine. receptor but paradoxically have the same therapeutic effects.
