Mandya celebrated its 75th year anniversary (Amrutha Mahotsava) in 2015. The KRS dam was built by Krishna Raja Wadiyar IV and M. Visvesvaraya in Mandya, opening in 1932. Mandya is home to a number of historically important sites. In 2016, Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) excavated another 13 ft (4.0 m) statue of Bahubali, a much revered figure among Jains. He was the son of Adinath, the first tirthankara of Jainism, and the younger brother of Bharata Chakravartin, identified with the 3rd – 9th centuries in Arthipura, Mandya district. The excavation is expected to be completed by 2018. Caryota urens species is a solitary-trunked tree that can measure 18 metres (59 feet) in height and up to 30 centimetres (12 inches) wide. Widely spaced leaf-scar rings cover its gray trunk which culminate in a 6 m (20 ft) wide, 6 m tall leaf crown. The bipinnate leaves are triangular in shape, bright to deep green, 3.5 m (11 ft) long, and held on 60 cm (24 in) long petioles. The obdeltoid pinnae are 30 cm long with a pointed edge and a jagged edge.

Description

In Sindh province of Pakistan, it is called layee or lai. In north Indian states, it is also known as gajak or maroonda. In Bangladesh, West Bengal and other Bengali-speaking regions, it is known as gur badam. In Maharashtra it is called as Chikki. In Kashmir it's known as Patti. In the South Indian states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, it is called palli patti (పల్లి పత్తి). In Kerala it is called kadala mittai; in Tamil Nadu, kadalai mittai; in Karnataka kadale Mittai. Similar dishes are also very popular in Brazil, where it is known as pé de moleque, in Paraguay, where it is called ka'i ladrillo, and in Thailand, where it is called thua tat.
