Louse eggs hatch 6–9 days after oviposition. Therefore, a common recommendation is to repeat treatment with a pediculicide at least once after 10 days, when all lice have hatched. Between the two treatments (Days 2–9) the person will still be infested with lice that hatch from eggs not killed by the anti-lice product. Among the leafy stems, the conical or club-shaped flower heads burst forth on separate and shorter stalks. These appear in the
