

When Does Bleeding Stop After Birth

The bleeding can be from the uterus, cervix, vagina and other tissue or organs located near the vagina. Postcoital bleeding can be one of the first indications of cervical cancer. There are other reasons why vaginal bleeding may occur after intercourse. Other symptoms include:

The presence of cervical polyps may result in postcoital bleeding during pregnancy because the tissue of the polyps is more easily damaged. Initial evaluation during diagnosis aims at determining pregnancy status, menopausal status, and the source of bleeding. One definition for diagnosing the condition is bleeding lasting more than 7 days or the loss of more than 80 mL of blood. Sex after pregnancy Painful intercourse is the most common sexual activity-related complication after childbirth. Sexual activity in the postpartum period other than sexual intercourse is possible sooner, but some women experience a prolonged loss of sexual desire after giving birth, which may be associated with postnatal depression. Injury to the perineum or surgical cuts (episiotomy) to the vagina during childbirth can cause sexual dysfunction. Vaginal dryness may occur following giving birth for Sex after pregnancy is often delayed for several weeks or months, and may be difficult and painful for women. Common issues that may last more than a year after birth are greater desire by the man than the woman, and a worsening of the woman's body image. PPH is defined by the World Health Organization as "blood loss of 500 ml or more within 24 hours after birth", though signs of shock (insufficient blood flow) have also been used as a definition. Some bleeding after childbirth is normal and is called lochia

and United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention provide guidance on the safety of birth control methods among women with specific medical conditions. The most effective methods of birth control are sterilization by means of vasectomy in males and tubal ligation in females, intrauterine devices (IUDs), and implantable birth control. This is followed by a number of hormone-based methods including contraceptive pills, patches, vaginal rings, and injections. Less effective methods include physical barriers such as condoms, diaphragms and fertility awareness methods. The least effective methods are spermicides and withdrawal by the male before ejaculation... cf5a8d615e Treatment depends on the underlying cause. Options may include hormonal birth control, gonadotropin-releasing hormone... cf5a8d615e Treatment depends on the cause, severity, and interference with quality of life. Initial treatments often involve birth control pills, tranexamic acid, danazol and hormonal intrauterine device. Painkillers (NSAIDs) are also helpful. Surgery can be effective for those whose symptoms are not well-controlled with other treatments. Approximately 53 in 1000 women are affected by AUB. cf5a8d615e

There are two main types of haemophilia: haemophilia A, which occurs due to low amounts of clotting factor VIII, and haemophilia B, which occurs due to low levels of clotting factor IX. They are typically inherited from one's parents through an X chromosome carrying a nonfunctional gene. Most commonly found in men, haemophilia can affect women too, though very rarely. A woman would need to inherit two affected X chromosomes to be affected, whereas a man would only need one X chromosome affected. It is possible for a new mutation... cf5a8d615e Abnormal uterine bleeding can be caused by structural abnormalities in the reproductive tract, skipping ovulation (anovulation), bleeding disorders, hormonal issues (such as hypothyroidism) or cancer of the reproductive tract. cf5a8d615e The underlying causes may be structural or non-structural and are classified in accordance with the FIGO system 1 & 2. Common causes include: Ovulation problems, fibroids, the lining of the uterus growing into the uterine wall, uterine polyps, underlying bleeding problems, side effects from birth control, or cancer. Susceptibility to each cause is often dependent on an individual's stage in life (prepubescent, premenopausal, postmenopausal). More than one category of causes may apply in an individual case. The first step in work-up is to rule out a tumor or pregnancy. Vaginal bleeding during pregnancy may be abnormal in certain circumstances. Medical imaging or hysteroscopy may help with the diagnosis. cf5a8d615e As this is a disorder that is present in an individual from birth, there are no warning signs to look for.
