However, when viewed from several miles to the north or south, the apparent local relief can be 600 to 950 feet (180 to 290 m), as the highest point of the top of the mound sits almost exactly 1,000 feet (300 m) above the Wisconsin River at Arena, 10 miles to the north. This makes West Blue Mound the most prominent peak in the state of Wisconsin. The mountain, as most of the other large mounds of the Driftless Area, is an outlier of Niagara dolomitic limestone.
