Gestational thrombocytopenia Although women with normal pregnancy experience a low platelet count, women experiencing a continuous drop in platelet will be diagnosed with thrombocytopenia and women with levels greater than 70,000/ μ L will be diagnosed with gestational thrombocytopenia. Thrombocytopenia is defined as the drop in platelet count from the normal range of 150,000–400,000/ μ L to a count lower than 150,000/ μ L. following symptoms – Nose bleeds Gums bleeding Blood in urine/stool Easily bruised Enlarged spleen Jaundice Continuous bleeding due to cuts Rash-like spots Gestational (incidental) thrombocytopenia is a condition that commonly affects pregnant women. Some researchers speculate the cause to be dependent on dilution, decreased production of platelets, or an increased turnover event. There is still ongoing research to determine the reason for the lowering of platelet count in women with a normal pregnancy 0b13be953e

These bacteria infect the gum tissue surrounding the teeth, leading to inflammation and, if left untreated, progressive damage to the teeth and gum tissue. Recent meta-analysis have shown that the composition of the oral microbiota and its response to periodontal disease differ between men and women. These differences are particularly notable in the advanced stages of periodontitis, suggesting that sex-specific factors may influence susceptibility and progression. Factors that increase the risk of disease include smoking, diabetes, HIV/AIDS, and almost any autoimmune... 0b13be953e Various classifications have been proposed to classify gingival recession, Miller's classification system being the one that is most widely followed. Many cases which are encountered in daily clinical practice cannot be classified according to the criteria of the present classification systems. Kumar & Masamatti's classification system gives a comprehensive depiction of recession defect that can be used to include cases that cannot be classified according to present classifications. A separate classification system for palatal recessions (PR) has been given. About a third of older people with peptic ulcers have no symptoms. Common causes Peptic ulcer disease refers to damage of the inner part of the stomach's gastric mucosa (lining of the stomach), the first part of the small intestine, or sometimes the lower esophagus. Complications may include bleeding, perforation, and blockage of the stomach. An ulcer in the stomach is called a gastric ulcer, while one in the first part of the intestines is a duodenal ulcer. The pain is often described as a burning or dull ache. With a gastric ulcer, the pain may worsen with eating 0b13be953e

Bleeding diathesis In medicine (hematology), bleeding diathesis is an unusual susceptibility to bleed (hemorrhage) mostly due to hypocoagulability (a condition of irregular In medicine (hematology), bleeding diathesis is an unusual susceptibility to bleed (hemorrhage) mostly due to hypocoagulability (a condition of irregular and slow blood clotting), in turn caused by a coagulopathy (a defect in the system of coagulation). Several types of coagulopathy are distinguished, ranging from mild to lethal. Therefore, this may result in the reduction of platelets being produced and leads to excessive bleeding. Also, coagulopathy can be contributed by impaired wound healing or impaired clot formation. Coagulopathy can be caused by thinning of the skin (Cushing's syndrome), such that the skin is weakened and is bruised easily and frequently without any trauma or injury to the body 0b13be953e
