

Cat Breed Devon Rex

As of 2023, the International Cat Association (TICA) recognizes 75 standardized breeds, the Cat Fanciers' Association (CFA) recognizes 45, the Fédération Internationale Féline (FIFe) recognizes 50, the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy (GCCF) recognizes 45, and the World Cat Federation (WCF) recognizes 69. e8cfda05dc
Inconsistency in a breed's classification and naming among registries means that an individual animal may be considered different breeds by different registries (though not necessarily eligible for registry in them all, depending on its exact ancestry). For example, TICA's Himalayan is considered a colorpoint variety of the Persian by the CFA, while the Javanese, (or Colorpoint Longhair) is a color variation of the Balinese in both the TICA and the CFA; both breeds are merged (along with the Colorpoint Shorthair) into a single "mega-breed", the... e8cfda05dc

In 1910, these two organisations merged to form the GCCF, which became the unified governing body and registry for the cat fancy. Today, the GCCF operates as an independent body with approximately 150 member clubs, including both specialist breed clubs and... e8cfda05dc The Selkirk Rex originated in Montana, USA in 1987, with a litter born to a rescued cat. The only unusually coated kitten in the litter was ultimately placed with breeder Jeri Newman, who named her Miss DiPesto, after a curly-haired character in the TV series Moonlighting played by Allyce Beasley. This foundation cat was bred to a black Persian tomcat, producing three Selkirk Rex and three straight-haired kittens. This demonstrated that the gene had an autosomal dominant mode of inheritance. All Selkirk Rex trace their ancestry back to the cat Miss DiPesto. Jeri Newman named the breed after her stepfather, "Selkirk," making this the first (and currently only) breed of cat to be named after an actual person. e8cfda05dc == History == e8cfda05dc The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy (GCCF) traces its origins to the earliest days of the modern

cat fancy, with its register dating back to the establishment of the National Cat Club in 1887; the first ever cat registry originating in England. Initially, the National Cat Club also served as the governing body for the cat fancy until 1910. In 1898, a rival registry, the Cat Club, was founded by Lady Marcus Beresford, but dissolved in 1903, giving way to the [British] Cat Fanciers' Association. During this period, cats could only be registered with one of the two competing registries. Breeders of some minority breeds actively seek major recognition for them, but have yet to receive it. For example, in regions where the formal cat fancy is in its infancy, naturally occurring native varieties – landraces – can be classified as minority breeds when attempts at selective breeding have begun to produce a formal natural breed with consistent traits, as is ongoing with the Aegean and Van cats. The current president of the CFA is Richard Mastin. e8cfda05dc American Shorthairs, Persians, Himalayans, Exotic Shorthairs, and British Shorthairs have been used as outcrosses to develop this breed. e8cfda05dc The skin of these cats has a texture of chamois leather, and may have fine hairs or be completely hairless. Whiskers may be present, either whole or broken, or may be totally absent. Per the breed

standards, they have a somewhat wedge-shaped head with large eyes and ears, quite long legs and tail, and neat rounded paws. Their skin is the color that their fur would be, and all the usual cat markings (solid, point, van, tabby, tortie, etc.) may be found on the Sphynx cat's skin. Because they have no fur, Sphynx cats lose body heat more readily than coated cats, making them both warm to the touch and prone to seeking out warm places. e8cfda05dc ACFA recognizes 70 breeds for championship competition. ACFA sanctioned cat shows include classes for registered kittens ages 4-8 months, for cats from an experimental breed or a new color, championship unaltered adult cats, championship altered cats, and a household pet class for mixed-breed or pedigreed cats who don't meet the breed standard. e8cfda05dc

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
