The large volume of water helps mitigate rapid changes in temperature, pH, electrical conductivity (EC), and nutrient solution composition. Also known as deep flow technique (DFT), floating raft technology (FRT), or raceway, this method uses a rectangular tank less than one foot deep filled with a nutrient-rich solution with plants floating in Styrofoam boards on top. This system was revised in 2010 to create RDWC. Typically, DWC is used to grow short-term, non-fruiting crops such as leafy greens and herbs 683311e488
