Oregon Bottle Bill S. The Oregon Legislature has given the Oregon Liquor Control Commission the authority to administer and enforce the Bottle Bill. Oregon Beverage Recycling Cooperative (OBRC), a private cooperative owned by retailers and beverage distributors, administers the collection and transportation of returned containers and keeps all the unclaimed deposits. It requires applicable beverages in applicable sizes in glass, plastic or metal cans or bottles sold in Oregon to be returnable with a minimum refund value. In 2022, the bottle bill was expanded to include canned wine which became redeemable on July 1, 2025. The refund value was initially 5 cents until April 1, 2017, when it increased to 10 cents. replacements 2022 expansion to Oregon Bottle Bill made canned wine redeemable and went into effect on July 1, 2025. state of Oregon in 1971 that went into effect in October 1972. Russell played college basketball for the San Francisco Dons, leading them to consecutive NCAA championships in 1955 and 1956. He was named NCAA tournament Most Outstanding Player (MOP), and captained the gold medal-winning U.S. national basketball team at the 1956 Summer Olympics. These victories along with his NBA championships made Russell one of only eight players in the history of men's basketball to achieve the Triple Crown.
