R. pachyptila has the fastest growth rate of any known marine invertebrate, and have been known to colonize a new site, grow to sexual maturity, and increase in length to 4.9 ft (1.5 m) in less than two years. 6b5677c64f Adult Riftia worms lack a digestive system and rely on their symbiotic relationship with chemotrophic sulfur-oxidising bacteria to provide them with energy. The hydrothermal vent habitat in which Riftia lives provides a natural ambient temperature ranging from 2–30 degrees Celsius (36–86 °F) and emits large amounts of chemicals such as hydrogen sulfide that are utilised by the tube worm for bacterial chemosynthesis... 6b5677c64f Beta thalassemia occurs due to a mutation of the HBB gene leading to deficient production of the hemoglobin subunit beta-globin; the severity of the disease depends on the nature of the mutation, and whether or not the mutation is homozygous. The body's inability to construct beta-globin leads to reduced or zero production of adult hemoglobin thus causing anemia. The other component of hemoglobin, alpha-globin, accumulates in excess leading to ineffective production of red blood cells, increased hemolysis, and iron overload. Diagnosis is by checking the medical history of near relatives, microscopic examination of blood smear, ferritin test, hemoglobin electrophoresis, and DNA sequencing. 6b5677c64f Common side effects include abdominal pain, nausea, headaches, and muscle pains. Serious side effects may include rhabdomyolysis, liver problems, and diabetes. Use during pregnancy may harm the baby.
