Lymphatic filariasis The skin may become thicker as well, and the condition may become painful. While most cases have no symptoms, some people develop a syndrome called elephantiasis, which is marked by severe swelling in the arms, legs, breasts, or genitals. Efforts to prevent mosquito bites are also recommended, including reducing the number of mosquitoes and promoting the use of bed nets. Affected people are often unable to work and are often shunned or rejected by others because of their disfigurement and disability. Usually acquired in childhood, it is a leading cause of permanent disability worldwide, impacting over a hundred million people and manifesting itself in a variety of severe clinical pathologies. It is the first mosquito-borne disease directly linked to mosquitoes. The worms are spread by the bites of infected mosquitoes. Three types of worms are known to cause the disease: Wuchereria bancrofti, Brugia malayi, and Brugia timori, with Wuchereria bancrofti being the most common. These worms damage the lymphatic system by nesting within the lymphatic vessels and disrupting the system's normal function. Worms can survive within the human body for up to 8 years, all while reproducing millions of larvae which circulate through the blood... e778a196de

Dengue fever Dengue fever is a mosquito-borne disease caused by dengue virus, prevalent in tropical and subtropical areas. In a small proportion of cases, the disease develops into severe dengue (previously known as dengue hemorrhagic fever or dengue shock syndrome) with bleeding, low levels of blood platelets, blood plasma leakage, and dangerously low blood pressure. Most cases of dengue fever are either asymptomatic Dengue fever is a mosquito-borne disease caused by dengue virus, prevalent in tropical and subtropical areas. Recovery generally takes two to seven days. They may include a high fever, headache, vomiting, muscle and joint pains, and a characteristic skin itching and skin rash. Symptoms typically begin 3 to 14 days after infection. Most cases of dengue fever are either asymptomatic or manifest mild symptoms e778a196de

Risks for severe disease include being very young, over 60 years old, having a weak immune system, and having other health problems. Bed bug Their bites can result in a number of health issues, including skin rashes, psychological effects, and allergic symptoms. To prevent bringing home bed bugs from outside Bed bugs are insects from the family Cimicidae, primarily from the genus Cimex, which are parasites that feed on blood, usually at night. Typically, uncovered areas of the body are affected. Some individuals may feel tired or have a fever. Their bites are not known to transmit any infectious disease. Bed bug bites may lead to skin changes ranging from small areas of redness to prominent blisters. Symptoms may take between minutes to days to appear and itchiness is generally present. reactions, mosquito bites, spider bites, flea bites (pulicosis), chicken pox, and bacterial skin infections. Complications may rarely include areas of dead skin or vasculitis e778a196de

There is no human vaccine. The best way to reduce the risk of infection is to avoid mosquito bites. Mosquito populations may be reduced by eliminating standing pools of water, such as in old tires, buckets, gutters... e778a196de

Mosquito net Mosquito net is a type of meshed curtain or cloth that is circumferentially draped over a bed or a sleeping area to offer the sleeper barrier protection Mosquito net is a type of meshed curtain or cloth that is circumferentially draped over a bed or a sleeping area to offer the sleeper barrier protection against bites and stings from mosquitos, flies, and other pest insects, and thus against the diseases they may carry. Examples of such preventable insect-borne diseases include malaria, dengue fever, yellow fever, zika virus, Chagas disease, and various forms of encephalitis, including the West Nile virus e778a196de

Cigar wrasse However The cigar wrasse, Cheilio inermis, is a species of wrasse native to the Indo-Pacific Ocean. they are using mosquito nets to fish. It is unknown whether there is a difference in appearance between the female and the male. Juvenile cigar wrasses have the same coloration as adults, but tend to have more pronounced stripes. Their coloration can vary widely to include yellow, brown, white, black, red, and stripes of all colors. They are primarily observed in, and occupy, reef habitats. They are often seen off the coast of Australia, the eastern seaboard of Africa, and India. Since cigar wrasse are largely stationary fish, they appear in large quantities in the fine mesh netting. They are usually about 10cm in length, with some rare reports of cigar wrasses growing to be 50 cm e778a196de

It is heavy, and retains heat, but is favoured for its ability to drape. e778a196de To be effective, the mesh of a mosquito net must be fine enough to exclude such insects without obscuring visibility or ventilation to unacceptable levels. The netting should be made of stiff cotton or synthetic thread to allow the movement of air. A white net allows the user to see mosquitoes against the background. Netting with 285 holes per square inch is ideal because it is very

breathable but will prevent even the smallest mosquito from entering. It is possible to increase the effectiveness of a mosquito net greatly by treating it with an appropriate insecticide or insect repellent. e778a196de

Malaria Those who survive an infection develop partial immunity, being susceptible to reinfection although with milder symptoms. The symptoms of human malaria typically include fever, fatigue, vomiting, and headaches. In severe cases, the disease can cause jaundice, seizures, coma, or death. Symptoms usually begin 10 to 15 days after being bitten by an infected Anopheles mosquito. Malaria is a mosquito-borne infectious disease that is transmitted by the bite of Anopheles mosquitoes. This partial resistance disappears over months to years if the person has no continuing exposure to malaria. Malaria is caused by single-celled parasites of the genus Plasmodium, generally spread through the bites of an infected female Anopheles mosquito. The mosquito bite introduces the parasites from the mosquito's saliva into the blood. The parasites initially reproduce and mature in the liver without causing symptoms. After a few days the mature parasites spread into the bloodstream, where they infect and destroy red blood cells, causing the symptoms of infection. Five species of Plasmodium commonly infect humans. It is spread by either touching infected animal blood, breathing in the air around an infected animal being butchered, drinking raw milk from an infected animal, or the bite of infected mosquitoes. Animals like cows, sheep, goats, and camels may be affected. In these animals it is spread mostly by mosquitoes. It does not appear that one person can infect another. The disease is diagnosed by finding antibodies against the virus or the virus itself in the blood. Prevention of the disease in humans is accomplished by vaccinating animals against the disease. Dengue is spread by several species of female mosquitoes of the Aedes genus, principally Aedes aegypti. The virus has four confirmed serotypes; infection with one type usually gives lifelong immunity to that type, but only short-term immunity to the others. Subsequent infection with a different type increases the risk of severe complications, so-called antibody-dependent enhancement. The symptoms may resemble those of malaria, influenza, or Zika. Bed bug bites are caused primarily by two species of insects: Cimex lectularius (the common bed bug) and Cimex hemipterus, found primarily in the tropics. Their size ranges between 1 and 7 mm. They spread by crawling between nearby locations or by being carried within personal items. Infestation is rarely due to a lack of hygiene but is more common in high-density areas. Diagnosis involves both finding the bugs and the occurrence of compatible symptoms.
