== History == Due to differences among the three species, each has been placed within a different genus, each consisting of one extant species. In the older literature, these three genera were placed within a family of their own, Desmodontidae, but taxonomists have now grouped them as a subfamily, Desmodontinae, in the New World leaf-nosed bat family, Phyllostomidae. Contrary to its Latin name, the spectral bat (*Vampyrum spectrum*) does not feed on blood.

Tinamou The word "tinamou" comes from the Galibi term for these birds, tinamu. opportunistic feeders and eat a wide range of foods, though each species varies in proportional dietary makeup. Tinamous first appear in the fossil record in the Miocene epoch. They are generally sedentary, ground-dwelling and, though not flightless, when possible avoid flight in favour of hiding or running away from danger. Tinamous are the only living group of palaeognaths able to fly, and were traditionally regarded as the sister group of the flightless ratites, but recent work places them well within the ratite radiation as most closely related to the extinct moa of New Zealand, implying flightlessness emerged among ratites multiple times. They are found in a variety of habitats, ranging from semi-arid alpine grasslands to tropical rainforests. Tinamou genera can be roughly divided into Tinamous () are members of the order Tinamiformes (), and family Tinamidae (), divided into two distinct

subfamilies, containing 46 species found in Mexico, Central America, and South America. The two subfamilies are broadly divided by habitat, with the Nothurinae referred to as steppe or open country tinamous, and the Tinaminae known as forest tinamous 65cd900a43

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
