It is found naturally in coffee and tea, and can be added to food as an additive. Caffeinated beverages are drinks with natural or artificially added caffeine, such as caffeinated alcoholic beverages, energy drinks, and colas. Some pills, like pain relievers, also contain caffeine. A 2015 study found that 89 percent of adults in the U.S. consume on average 200 mg of caffeine daily, between 2001 and 2010. One area of concern that has been presented is the relationship between pregnancy and caffeine consumption, as repeated caffeine doses of 100 mg appeared to result in higher risk of low birth weight. A headache diary can be useful in tracking when and where pain occurs, how severe it is, and how long the pain lasts. The disease is considered among the most painful conditions known to medical science. Episodes are often accompanied by eye watering, nasal congestion, drooping eyelids, or swelling around the eye on the affected side. Between cluster periods are pain-free intervals without headaches, which last a little less than one year, but some patients can have chronic cluster headaches without remission periods. A record of Cluster headache is a neurological disorder characterized by episodes of severe headaches on one side of the head, typically around the eye and temple, lasting between 15 minutes to three hours
