Bhavana The word bhavana normally appears in conjunction with another word forming a compound phrase such as citta-bhavana (the development or cultivation of the heart/mind) or metta-bhavana (the development/cultivation of loving-kindness). When used on its own, bhavana signifies contemplation and 'spiritual cultivation' generally. The word bhavana Bhāvanā (Pali; Sanskrit: भवना, also bhāvanā) literally means "development" or "cultivating" or "producing" in the sense of "calling into

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Poiesis "Allopoiesis In continental philosophy and semiotics, poiesis (; from Ancient Greek: ποίησις) is the process of emergence of something that did not previously exist. Forms of poiesis—including autopoiesis, the process of sustenance through the emergence of sustaining parts—are considered in philosophy and semiotics to be the foundation of activity, alongside semiosis which is considered the foundation of the production of meaning. the craftsman is not to generate the meaning, but rather to cultivate in himself the skill for discerning the meanings that are already there

Ryot originates from the Hindi-Urdu word ra`īyat and the Arabic word ra`īyah, translated as "flock" or "peasants", in turn

originating from the word *ra`ā*, meaning "pasture". To explain the cultural context of the historical Buddha's employment of the term, Glenn Wallis emphasizes *bhavana*'s sense of cultivation. He writes that a farmer performs *bhavana* when he or she prepares soil and plants a seed. Wallis infers the Buddha's intention with this term by emphasizing the terrain and focus on farming in northern India at the time in the following passage: A loanword from Spanish, *malpaís* is in wide use in English in the southwest United States. The literal translation of *malpaís* is "badcountry." Other Spanish terms for badlands are *tierras baldías* and *cárcava*.
