In 2006, McNeil Consumer Healthcare, a subsidiary of Johnson & Johnson, acquired the brand from Pfizer Consumer Healthcare. In 2013, McNeil sold the brand to Sanofi, following a two-year period where the brand was pulled off the market due to product recalls resulting from quality control and manufacturing issues that

Rolaid's returned to the market at the beginning of September 2013 under Chattem ownership with new packaging, trade dress, and a new liquid variety.
