Nasogastric intubation also has the benefit of providing pain relief resulting from gastric distention Colic in horses is defined as abdominal pain, but it is a clinical symptom rather than a diagnosis. The incidence of colic in the general horse population has been estimated between 4 and 10 percent over the course of the average lifespan. The most common forms of colic are gastrointestinal in nature and are most often related to colonic disturbance. Recognizing and understanding these signs is pivotal, as timely action can spell the difference between a brief moment of discomfort and a life-threatening situation. to fluid back-up and distention of the stomach. What makes it tricky is that different causes can manifest with similar signs of distress in the animal.
