Discovery and development of beta-blockers β adrenergic receptor antagonists (also called beta-blockers or β -blockers) were initially developed in the 1960s, for the treatment of angina pectoris but are now also used for hypertension, congestive heart failure and certain arrhythmias. In the 1950s, dichloroisoproterenol (DCI) was discovered to be a β -antagonist that blocked the effects of sympathomimetic amines on bronchodilation, uterine relaxation and heart stimulation. Although DCI had no clinical utility, a change in the compound did provide a clinical candidate, pronethalol, which was introduced in 1962. (pindolol), concomitant α -adrenergic blocking activity (for example labetalol and carvedilol) and additional direct vasodilator activity (nebivolol) e9c4146755

The use of a drug with a single enantiomer intends to make it more effective. One enantiomer of a drug may have a desired beneficial effect while the other may cause serious and undesired side effects, or sometimes even beneficial but entirely different effects. The desired enantiomer of a given drug is known as the eutomer while the undesired enantiomer is known as the distomer. When equal amounts of both enantiomers are found in a mixture, the mixture is known as a racemic mixture. If a mixture for a drug does not have a 1:1 ratio of its enantiomers it is a candidate for an enantiopure drug. e9c4146755 Common side effects include dizziness, feeling tired, nausea, and headaches. Propranolol It can be taken orally, rectally, or by intravenous injection. The formulation that is taken orally comes in short-acting and long-acting versions. Propranolol appears in the blood after 30 minutes and has a maximum effect between 60 and 90 minutes when taken orally. potentially makes dual alpha-1 and beta blockers like labetalol and carvedilol more favorable for such purposes than selective beta blockers like propranolol Propranolol is a medication of the beta blocker class. It is used to treat high blood pressure, some types of irregular heart rate, thyrotoxicosis, capillary hemangiomas, akathisia, performance anxiety, and essential tremors, as well as to prevent migraine headaches, and to prevent further heart problems in those with angina or previous heart attacks e9c4146755

His Imperial College patents have formed the basis of companies specialising in the treatment of cachexia (Myotec and PsiOxus).
