However, assessment for malocclusion should also take into account aesthetics and the impact on functionality. If these aspects are acceptable to the patient despite meeting the formal definition of malocclusion, then treatment may not be necessary. Cheek teeth Viewed from the side, these teeth have a series of triangular cusps or ridges, enabling the ruminants' sideways jaw motions to break down tough vegetable matter. Cheek teeth are multicuspidate (having many folds or tubercles). Apart from helping Cheek teeth or postcanines comprise the molar and premolar teeth in mammals. In contrast, the cheek teeth of deer and cattle are selenodont. Cheek teeth are sometimes separated from the incisors by a gap called a diastema. This scissor-like pairing of the last upper premolar and first lower molar is adapted for shearing meat. Cheek teeth in reptiles are much simpler as compared to mammals. Mammals have multicuspidate molars (three in placentals, four in marsupials, in each jaw quadrant) and premolars situated between canines and molars whose shape and number varies considerably among particular groups. For example, many modern Carnivora possess carnassials, or secodont teeth. are sometimes separated from the incisors by a gap called a diastema 85a12f5cb7

The book provides advice on treating tooth decay, recommending cleaning the cavity and filling it with gold leaf. This advice is attributed to Mesue, though his identity is uncertain. Dental sealant Dental sealants are mainly used in children who are at higher risk of tooth decay, and are usually placed as soon as the adult molar teeth come through. As Dental sealants (also termed pit and fissure sealants, or simply fissure sealants) are a dental treatment intended to prevent tooth decay. Dental sealants are materials placed in these pits and fissures to fill them in, creating a smooth surface which is easy to clean. Teeth have recesses on their biting surfaces; the back teeth have fissures (grooves) and some front teeth have cingulum pits. provide a smooth surface that is easily accessible for both the natural protective factor, saliva and the toothbrush bristles when cleaning the teeth. It is these pits and fissures that are most vulnerable to tooth decay because food and bacteria stick in them and because they are hard-to-clean areas 85a12f5cb7

Dentures Cleaning can be done Dentures (also known as false teeth) are prosthetic devices constructed to replace missing teeth, supported by the surrounding soft and hard tissues of the oral cavity. There are two main categories of dentures, the distinction being whether they fit onto the mandibular arch or on the maxillary arch. Conventional dentures are removable (removable partial denture or complete denture). However, there are many denture designs, some of which rely on bonding or clasping onto teeth or dental implants (fixed prosthodontics). Plaque and tartar can build up on false teeth, just as they do on natural teeth. Daily cleaning of dentures is recommended. £300 85a12f5cb7

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The malocclusion classification is based on the relationship of the mesiobuccal cusp of the maxillary first molar and the buccal groove of the mandibular first molar. If this molar relationship exists, then the teeth can align into normal occlusion. According to Angle, malocclusion is any deviation of the occlusion from the ideal. 85a12f5cb7

Malocclusion The word derives from mal- 'incorrect' and occlusion 'the manner in which opposing teeth meet'. The English-language term dates from 1864; Edward Angle (1855 – 1930), the "father of modern orthodontics," popularised it. In orthodontics, a malocclusion is a misalignment or incorrect relation between the teeth of the upper and lower dental arches when they approach each other as the jaws close 85a12f5cb7

People routinely clean their own teeth by brushing and interdental cleaning, and dental hygienists can remove hardened deposits (tartar) not removed by routine cleaning.
