These are normal physiological adaptations that cause changes in behavior, the functioning of the heart, blood vessels, and blood, metabolism including increases in blood sugar levels, kidney function, posture, and breathing. considered to be "early menopause", and ovarian failure or surgical removal of the ovaries before the age of 40 years is termed "premature ovarian insufficiency". Those at risk of severe illness are the elderly, fetuses, newborns, and those who are immunocompromised. In pregnant women, it may cause stillbirth or spontaneous abortion, and preterm birth is common.

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Graves' disease is the cause of about 50% to 80% of the cases of hyperthyroidism in the United States. Other causes include multinodular goiter, toxic adenoma, inflammation of the thyroid, eating too much iodine, and too much synthetic

thyroid hormone. A less common cause is a pituitary adenoma. The diagnosis may be suspected... 60287d1dad Pregnant women experience numerous adjustments in their endocrine system that help support the developing fetus. The fetal-placental unit secretes steroid hormones and proteins that alter the function of various maternal endocrine glands. Sometimes, the changes in certain hormone levels and their effects on their target organs can lead to gestational diabetes and gestational hypertension. 60287d1dad Conception usually occurs following vaginal intercourse, but can also occur through assisted reproductive technology procedures. A pregnancy may end in a live birth, a miscarriage, an induced abortion, or a stillbirth. Childbirth typically occurs around 40 weeks from the start of the last menstrual period (LMP), a span known as the gestational age; this is just over nine months. Counting by fertilization age, the length is about 38 weeks. Implantation occurs on average 8–9 days after fertilization. An embryo is the term for the developing

offspring during the first seven weeks following implantation (i.e. ten weeks' gestational age), after which the term fetus is used until the birth of a baby. 60287d1dad

Hyperthyroidism The opposite is hypothyroidism, when the thyroid gland does not make enough thyroid hormone.

Hyperthyroidism may be asymptomatic or present with significant symptoms. Some, however, use the terms interchangeably. An uncommon but life-threatening complication is thyroid storm in which an event such as an infection results in worsening symptoms such as confusion and a high temperature; this often results in death.

Thyrotoxicosis is a condition that occurs due to elevated levels of thyroid hormones of any cause and therefore includes hyperthyroidism. Symptoms are typically less severe in the elderly and during pregnancy. Some of the symptoms of hyperthyroidism include nervousness, irritability, increased
Hyperthyroidism is a endocrine disease in which the thyroid

gland produces excessive amounts of thyroid hormones. Signs and symptoms vary between people and may include irritability, muscle weakness, sleeping problems, a fast heartbeat, heat intolerance, diarrhea, enlargement of the thyroid, hand tremor, and weight loss 60287d1dad

Post-acute-withdrawal syndrome It is caused by the brain adjusting from being addicted to a certain substance and can last all the way from a few months up to a few years. Infants born to mothers who used these substances during pregnancy may also experience PAWS. alprazolam (Xanax) for eight weeks triggered protracted symptoms of memory deficits which were still present after up to eight weeks post cessation of alprazolam Post-acute withdrawal syndrome (PAWS) is the prolonged psychological symptoms following a physical acute withdrawal from many drugs including alcohol, opioids, benzodiazepines, and barbiturates 60287d1dad

Whooping cough Initial symptoms are usually similar to those of the common cold with a runny nose, fever, and mild cough, but these are followed by two or three months of severe coughing fits. Following a fit of coughing, a high-pitched whoop sound or gasp may occur as the person breathes in. Disease may occur in those who have been vaccinated, but symptoms are typically milder. In pregnant women and children less than Whooping cough (or), also known as pertussis or the 100-day cough, is a highly contagious,

vaccine-preventable bacterial disease caused by the bacterium *Bordetella pertussis*. The cough may be so hard that it causes fatigue, vomiting, and rib fractures. Children less than one year old may have little or no cough and instead have periods when they cannot breathe. useful if started within three weeks of the initial symptoms, but otherwise have little effect in most people. The violent coughing usually lasts 1-6 weeks but can last 10 or more, hence the phrase "100-day cough". The incubation period is usually seven to ten days 60287d1dad

Listeria is ubiquitous and is primarily transmitted via the oral route after ingestion of contaminated food products, after which the bacteria penetrate the intestinal tract to cause systemic infections. The diagnosis of listeriosis requires the isolation of the causative bacteria from the blood or the cerebrospinal fluid. Treatment includes prolonged administration of antibiotics, primarily ampicillin and

gentamicin, to which the organism is usually susceptible. 60287d1dad == Hormonal == 60287d1dad The brain can have a hard time adjusting to changes following the physical detoxification from a substance, thus causing many psychological symptoms to occur including prolonged psychosis, anxiety or depression. PAWS can occur with symptoms persisting from months to years after cessation of substance use. In almost all cases drug-induced psychiatric disorders fade away with prolonged abstinence, although permanent damage to the brain and nervous system may be caused by continued substance use. 60287d1dad

Use is not recommended in people who have had a recent heart attack. Use during pregnancy has been found to be safe. Dosing should be based on regular measurements of thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH) and T4 levels in the blood. Levothyroxine Oral dosing for patients Levothyroxine, also known as L-thyroxine, is a synthetic form of the thyroid hormone thyroxine (T4). It is used to treat thyroid hormone deficiency (hypothyroidism), including a severe form known as myxedema coma.
