1993 Bishopsgate bombing Telephoned warnings were sent about an hour beforehand, but a news photographer was killed in the blast and 44 people were injured, with fatalities minimised due to its occurrence on a Saturday. York City in February 1993 had caused bankruptcy in 40% of the affected companies within two years of the attack, according to a report from analysts On 24 April 1993, the Provisional Irish Republican Army (IRA) detonated a powerful truck bomb on Bishopsgate, a major thoroughfare in London's financial district, the City of London. The blast destroyed the nearby St Ethelburga's church and wrecked Liverpool Street station and the NatWest Tower

Many-worlds is also called the relative state formulation or the Everett interpretation, after physicist Hugh Everett, who first proposed it in 1957.
