Birth defects may result from genetic or chromosomal disorders, exposure to certain medications or chemicals, or certain infections during pregnancy. Many birth defects are believed to involve multiple factors. Birth defects may be visible at birth or diagnosed by screening tests. == History == Prevention may be partly achieved through early introduction of peanuts to the diets of pregnant women and babies. It is recommended that babies at high risk be given peanut products in areas where medical care is available as early as 4 months of age. Oral immunotherapy results in some degree of tolerance in about 65% of children, though side effects are frequent. The principal treatment for anaphylaxis is the injection of epinephrine. Semen is collected from animals for artificial insemination or cryoconservation of genetic material. Cryoconservation of animal genetic resources is a practice that calls for the collection of semen in efforts for conservation of a particular breed.
