She was mentioned in the Midas List for three consecutive years, from 2005 to 2007. She claimed that a number of firms in the 1980s ignored her senior management experience in Hambrecht & Quist. In addition to finding that women make up the majority of early technology adopters, Harvard Business School Professor Paul Gompers has stated that female venture capitalists consistently perform as well as males at large firms that have more than one woman. 6e981f39f7

Social entrepreneurs, however, are either non-profits, or they blend for-profit goals with generating a positive "return to society". Therefore, they use different metrics. For-profit entrepreneurs typically measure performance using business metrics like profit, revenues and increases in stock prices. This concept may be applied to a wide range of organizations, which vary in size, aims, and beliefs.
