Long QT syndrome may be present at birth or develop later in life. The inherited form may occur by itself or as part of a larger genetic disorder. Onset later in life may result from certain medications, low blood potassium, low blood calcium, or heart failure. Medications that are implicated include certain antiarrhythmics, antibiotics, and antipsychotics. LQTS can be diagnosed using an electrocardiogram (EKG) if a corrected QT interval of greater than 450–500 milliseconds is found, but clinical findings, other

EKG features, and genetic testing may confirm the diagnosis with shorter QT intervals. Common side effects include sleepiness, dry mouth, headache, and abdominal pain. The degree of sleepiness that occurs is generally less than with first-generation antihistamines because second-generation antihistamines are more selective for the H1 receptor. Compared to other second-generation antihistamines, cetirizine can cause drowsiness. Among second-generation antihistamines, cetirizine is more likely than fexofenadine and loratadine to cause drowsiness, but cetirizine shows superior efficacy in the histamine induced wheal and flare paradigm and tends to produce slightly greater clinical symptom relief than fexofenadine, which in turn tends to produce greater symptom relief than loratadine, meanwhile loratadine was unable to show significant superiority over placebo. The incidence and clinical significance of cardiac arrhythmias during long-term exposure to microgravity experienced on the International Space Station (ISS) or during a prolonged (that is, up to 3 years) sojourn to Mars or on the Moon are a concern for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA). However, the potential catastrophic nature of a sudden cardiac death... == Background == Romano-Ward syndrome is caused by abnormal variants in the genes responsible for producing certain proteins used to transport charged particles (ion channels) within the heart. These abnormalities interfere with the electrical signals that heart cells use to coordinate contractions, causing the heart to take longer to recharge in between beats. The condition is

usually diagnosed using an electrocardiogram, but other tests sometimes used include Holter monitoring, exercise testing, and genetic testing. It may be treated using medications such as beta-blockers, an implantable cardioverter-defibrillator, or surgery to disrupt the sympathetic nervous system. Romano-Ward syndrome is associated with a prolonged QTc, although Romano-Ward syndrome is the most common form of congenital long QT syndrome (LQTS), a genetic heart condition that affects the electrical properties of heart muscle cells. Romano-Ward syndrome can be distinguished

forms of LQTS are associated with other symptoms and signs, including deafness and periods of muscle weakness. It results in an increased risk of an irregular heartbeat which can result in fainting, drowning, seizures, or sudden death. These episodes can be triggered by exercise or stress. Long QT syndrome is associated with a prolonged QTc, although Long QT syndrome (LQTS) is a condition affecting repolarization (relaxing) of the heart after a heartbeat, giving rise to an abnormally lengthy QT interval

Arrhythmia occurring after every normal beat are termed ventricular bigeminy PVCs that occur at intervals of 2 normal beats to 1 PVC, or 1 normal beat to 2 PVCs, are Arrhythmias, also known as cardiac arrhythmias, are irregularities in the heartbeat, including when it is too fast or too slow. Others may result in sudden death. In more serious cases, there may be lightheadedness, passing out, shortness of breath, chest pain, or decreased level of consciousness. A resting heart rate that is too

fast - above 100 beats per minute in adults - is called tachycardia, and a resting heart rate that is too slow - below 60 beats per minute - is called bradycardia. While most cases of arrhythmia are not serious, some predispose a person to complications such as stroke or heart failure. Symptoms, when present, may include palpitations or feeling a pause between heartbeats. Essentially, this is anything but normal sinus rhythm. Some types of arrhythmias have no symptoms ad8ddec999

Drug-induced QT prolongation The value for a normal QT interval is similar in males and females from birth up to adolescence. On an EKG, the QT interval represents the summation of action potentials in cardiac muscle cells, which can be caused by an increase in inward current through sodium or calcium channels, or a decrease in outward current through potassium channels. Excessive QT prolongation can trigger tachycardias such as

torsades de pointes (TdP). By binding to and inhibiting the "rapid" delayed rectifier potassium current protein, certain drugs are able to decrease the outward flow of potassium ions and extend the length of phase 3 myocardial repolarization, resulting in QT prolongation. QT prolongation is an established side effect of antiarrhythmics, but can also be caused by a wide range of non-cardiac medicines, including antibiotics, antidepressants, antipsychotics, antihistamines, opioids, and complementary medicines. It is an electrical disturbance which can be seen on an electrocardiogram (EKG). relaxation. Arrhythmias are often categorized into four groups: extra beats, supraventricular tachycardias, ventricular arrhythmias and bradyarrhythmias. Extra beats include premature atrial contractions, premature ventricular contractions and premature junctional contractions. Electrocardiography This analysis calculates features such as the PR interval, QT interval, corrected QT (QTc) interval, PR axis, QRS axis, rhythm and more. It is an electrogram of the heart

which is a graph of voltage versus time of the electrical activity of the heart using electrodes placed on the skin. These electrodes detect the small electrical changes that are a consequence of cardiac muscle depolarization followed by repolarization during each cardiac cycle (heartbeat). The results from Electrocardiography is the process of using an electrocardiograph (a device) to produce an electrocardiogram (a recording, often called an ECG or EKG) that shows a line graph of the heart's electrical activity through repeated cardiac cycles. Changes in the normal ECG pattern occur in numerous cardiac abnormalities, including: ad8ddec999

Trimipramine's primary use in medicine is in the treatment of major depressive disorder, especially where sedation is helpful due to its prominent sedative effects. The drug is also an effective anxiolytic, and can be used in the treatment of anxiety. In addition to depression and anxiety, trimipramine is effective in the treatment of insomnia, and unlike most other hypnotics, does

Cardiac rhythm problems during spaceflight Most of these have been related to cardiovascular disease, but it is not clear whether this was due to pre-existing conditions or effects of space flight. It is hoped that advanced screening for coronary disease has greatly mitigated this risk. Beyond these terrestrial heart risks, some concern exists that prolonged exposure to microgravity may lead to heart rhythm disturbances. Other heart rhythm problems, such as atrial fibrillation, can develop over time, necessitating periodic screening of crewmembers' heart rhythms. Although this has not been observed to date, further surveillance is warranted. after long-duration missions QTc intervals are slightly prolonged in crewmembers who did not
