The term cold war is used because there was no direct fighting between the two superpowers, though each supported opposing sides in regional conflicts known as proxy wars. It began in the aftermath of the Second World War and ended with the dissolution of the Soviet Union in 1991

Risk factors include going to child care facilities, not sleeping well, and psychological stress. They were used with varying success in the explorations of both poles, as well as during the Alaskan gold rush. Sled dog teams delivered mail to rural communities in Alaska, Yukon, Northwest Territories and Nunavut.
