An RTOS mainly targets resource constrained devices like microcontrollers. The most basic way to implement checkpointing is to stop the application, copy all the required data from the memory to reliable storage (e.g., parallel file system), then continue with execution. In the case of failure, when the application restarts, it does not need to start from scratch. Rather, it will read the latest state ("the checkpoint") from the stable storage and execute from that point. While there is ongoing debate on whether checkpointing is the dominant I/O workload on distributed computing systems, the general consensus is that checkpointing is one of the major I/O workloads. c24b6f3dfb
