Archived from the The documented history of Madrid dates to the 9th century, even though the area has been inhabited since the Stone Age. Conquered by Christians in 1083 or 1085, Madrid consolidated in the Late Middle Ages as a middle to upper-middle rank town of the Crown of Castile. The primitive nucleus of Madrid, a walled military outpost in the left bank of the Manzanares, dates back to the second half of the 9th century, during the rule of the Emirate of Córdoba 1e19195eb9

Peña 2012, Dibujo animado y The Golden Age of Argentine cinema (Spanish: Época de Oro del cine argentino or other equivalent names), sometimes known interchangeably as the broader classical or classical-industrial period (Spanish: período clásico-industrial), is an era in the history of the cinema of Argentina that began in the 1930s and lasted until the 1940s or 1950s, depending on the definition, during which national film production underwent a process of industrialization and standardization that involved the emergence of mass production, the establishment of the studio, genre and star systems, and the adoption of the institutional mode of representation (MRI) that was mainly—though not exclusively—spread by Hollywood, quickly becoming one of the most popular film industries across Latin America and the Spanish-speaking world. Neoliberalism in Peru Neoliberalism is a political and economic ideology that advocates for free-market capitalism, and is known as Neoliberalismo in Spanish. The term has multiple, competing definitions, and is often used pejoratively. Although it suffered a setback in 1998, during the 1997 Asian financial crisis, it recovered and intensified during the period of greatest economic growth, driven by the commodities boom, between 2003 and 2013. Its turning point came in the 1990s with the implementation of the Fujishock, a set of drastic economic measures taken by President Alberto Fujimori inspired by the US government based on the Washington Consensus, and with the promulgation of the 1993 Political Constitution, which was heavily influenced by neoliberalism.
