PUPPP usually first appears on the abdomen and often spreads to the legs, feet, arms, chest, and neck. The face is usually not affected. Skin distension (stretching) is thought to be a possible trigger for PUPPP as it most commonly affects primigravida (women in their first pregnancy), those with large fundal measurements (distance from the pubic bone to the top of the uterus) and/or those who are carrying large babies or multiples. The papules and plaques often first appear within stretch marks... 4baf41a211 The "GI cocktail" does not refer to a specific product. Rather, it refers to a mixture of viscous lidocaine, an antacid, and an anticholinergic. Viscous lidocaine works as an anesthetic to numb pain in the throat, esophagus, and stomach. Antacids work to neutralize stomach acid. Anticholinergics work to ease symptoms that accompany dyspepsia including nausea, vomiting, and abdominal cramping. 4baf41a211 In higher organisms, an allergic response may be the cause of irritation. Dogger Bank itch rashes and inflammation, cracking of the skin, redness in the area, pus leaking from aforementioned cracks, and intense itching of the area. The disease, common in fishermen who work in the North Sea, has been recognized by the Danish Workman's Compensation Act since 1939. The rash Dogger Bank itch is a cutaneous condition characterized by a long-lasting dermatitis caused by exposure to the sea chervil, Alcyonidium diaphanum, a bryozoan 4baf41a211

Other classic features of tinea corporis include: 4baf41a211 Newly emerged and mated females inject a neurotoxin-containing saliva into their hosts, which paralyzes the host and enables the gravid female mites to feed on the host's hemolymph. Irritation Irritants are typically thought of as chemical agents (for example phenol and capsaicin) but mechanical, thermal (heat), and radiative stimuli (for example ultraviolet light or ionising radiations) can also be irritants. The affected areas are always dry, scaly, reddish and may ooze sometimes. Sometimes, the itching will be associated with a skin rash. dry skin. Eczema Irritation, in biology and physiology, is a state of inflammation or painful reaction to allergy or cell-lining damage. Irritation also has non-clinical usages referring to bothersome physical or psychological pain or discomfort. A stimulus or agent which induces the state of irritation is an irritant 4baf41a211

Pruritic urticarial papules and plaques of pregnancy marks. Very Pruritic urticarial papules and plaques of pregnancy (PUPPP), known in the United Kingdom as polymorphic eruption of pregnancy (PEP), is a chronic hives-like rash that strikes some women during pregnancy. Some skin changes are known to occur in people who are pregnant while other skin conditions, or dermatoses, that people have prior to getting pregnant will become altered or symptoms will increase. PUPPP is one of many skin conditions that is specific to pregnancy and occurs in about 1 in every 160 (0. 625%) pregnancies. This rash may then move to other areas of the body, including, but not limited to the trunk of the body, arms, legs, feet, chest, and neck 4baf41a211

Common causes of rashes include: 4baf41a211 Chronic irritation is a medical term signifying that afflictive health conditions have been present for a while. There are many disorders that can cause chronic irritation, the majority involve the skin, vagina, eyes and lungs. 4baf41a211 It may have a variety of appearances; most easily identifiable are the enlarging raised red rings with a central area of clearing (ringworm). The same appearances of ringworm may also occur on the scalp (tinea capitis), beard area (tinea barbae) or the groin (tinea cruris, known as jock itch or dhobi itch). 4baf41a211 == Signs and symptoms == 4baf41a211 A rash may be localized in one part of the body, or affect all the skin. Rashes may cause the skin to change color, itch, become warm, bumpy, chapped, dry, cracked or blistered, swell, and may be painful. The causes, and therefore treatments for rashes, vary widely. Diagnosis must take into account such things as the appearance of the rash, other symptoms, what the patient may have been exposed to, occupation, and occurrence in family members. The diagnosis may confirm any number of conditions. The presence of a rash may aid diagnosis; associated signs and symptoms are diagnostic of certain diseases. For example, the rash in measles is an erythematous, morbilliform, maculopapular rash that begins a few days after the fever starts. == Signs and symptoms == 4baf41a211 The shrub grows to 0.6–1.2 metres (2–4 ft) tall. Its leaves are 15 centimetres (6 inches) long, alternate, with three lobes on each. The lobes are usually hairy and are variable in size and shape, but most often resemble white oak leaves; they usually turn yellow or orange in autumn. The yellow flowers bloom from March to April. The fruit is about 1/4 inch (6.4 mm) wide and greenish white. 4baf41a211 Although acne can often involve superficial infection and inflammation of some hair follicles, the condition of those follicles is usually not called folliculitis, as that term is usually reserved for the separate set of disease entities comprising infected and inflamed hair follicles with causes other than acne. 4baf41a211 It presents no long-term risk for either the woman or fetus as there is no statistical increase of risk of premature labor or fetal loss, despite frequently severe pruritus. 4baf41a211 Irritation can also be induced by some allergic response due to exposure of some allergens for example contact dermatitis, irritation of mucosal membranes and pruritus. Mucosal membrane is the most common site of irritation because it contains secretory glands that release mucus which attracts the allergens due to its sticky nature. 4baf41a211

Tinea corporis The edge of the rash appears elevated and is scaly to touch. Itching occurs on infected area. Specifically, it is a type of dermatophytosis (or ringworm) that appears on the arms and legs, especially on glabrous skin; however, it may occur on any superficial part of the body. Sometimes the skin surrounding the rash may be dry and flaky Tinea corporis is a fungal infection of the body, similar to other forms of tinea 4baf41a211

Signs of Dogger Bank itch can be found mainly on the arms, wrists, hands, insides of elbows but can spread if the affected person doesn't take prevention measures. The symptoms are rashes and inflammation, cracking of the skin, redness in the area, pus leaking from aforementioned cracks, and intense itching of the area. 4baf41a211

GI cocktail Viscous lidocaine: Allergic reaction such as rash, itching, or hives. The GI cocktail generally contains a mixture of viscous lidocaine, an antacid, and an anticholinergic. While it has been widely used in the treatment of dyspepsia, studies have suggested that the GI cocktail is only as effective as antacids alone. Swelling of the lips, tongue, mouth, face, and throat is possible in severe cases Numbness/tingling A gastrointestinal cocktail, (also known as a GI cocktail or gastric cocktail), is a mixture of medications used to treat symptoms of dyspepsia. The GI cocktail is commonly prescribed in the hospital or emergency department, and has been used to help distinguish chest pain as either gastrointestinal or cardiac 4baf41a211

Referred itch The stimulus and referred itch are ipsilateral (the stimulus and the referred itch occur on the same side of the body). There are two types of referred itch: normal and acquired (pathological) Referred itch or mitempfindung is the phenomenon in which a stimulus applied in one region of the body is felt as an itch or irritation in a different part of the body. The referred sensation itself should not be painful; it is more of an irritating prickle leading to the compulsion to scratch the area. The syndrome is relatively harmless, though it can be irritating, and healthy individuals can express symptoms. The itching sensation is spontaneous and can cease with continued stimulation. The itching sensation is spontaneous and can cease with continued stimulation. unidirectional. Also, because scratching or putting pressure on the referred itch does not cause the stimulus area to itch, the relationship between the stimulus and the referred itch is unidirectional. Stimuli range from a firm pressure applied to the skin—a scratch—to irritation or pulling on a hair follicle on the skin 4baf41a211
