In mammals, the fertilized embryo Sex is the phenotypic trait of a sexually reproducing organism in producing gametes of one of two different sizes or shapes—male or female gametes. Egg cells are often associated with other cells which support the development of the embryo, forming an egg. Sex is often referred to as biological sex when using the word sex alone could be ambiguous with other meanings of sex. By convention, organisms that produce smaller gametes (spermatozoa, sperm) are called male, while organisms that produce larger gametes (ova, often called egg cells) are called female. During sexual reproduction, a male and a female gamete fuse to form a zygote, which develops into an offspring that inherits traits from each parent. An organism that produces both types of gamete is a hermaphrodite 329c4d4432

Female reproductive system The small external part of the clitoris, just below the mons Venus, helps with arousal and orgasm. The female reproductive tract is made of several connected internal organs—the vagina, uterus, and fallopian tubes—and is prone to infections. The fertilized ovum becomes an embryo, develops into a fetus and gestates until childbirth. The uterus (or womb) accommodates the embryo by developing the uterine lining. exclusively for this purpose. The reproductive system is immature at birth and develops at puberty to be able to release matured ova from the ovaries, facilitate their fertilization with sperm, and create a protective environment for the developing fetus during pregnancy. The vagina allows for sexual intercourse and childbirth, and is connected to the uterus at the cervix. The tract is protected by a fold called the labia majora and a flap called the labia minora. Partner-assisted reproduction Once the egg is fertilized, embryos are obtained that are kept in the lab for 3 to 5 days, when they develop to blastocysts Partner-assisted reproduction, reception of oocytes from partner (ROPA), reciprocal IVF, shared motherhood, partner IVF or co-IVF is a method of family building that is used by couples who both possess female reproductive organs. Reciprocal IVF offers the highest chance for pregnancy. The method uses in vitro fertilization (IVF), a method that means eggs are removed from the ovaries, fertilized in a laboratory, and then one or more of the resulting embryos are placed in the uterus to hopefully create a pregnancy. Reciprocal IVF differs from standard IVF in that two partners are involved: the eggs are taken from one partner, and the other partner carries the pregnancy.

The uterus also produces secretions which help the transit of sperm to the fallopian tubes, where one of them can fertilize the ovum. Mitochondrial replacement therapy Eight babies have been born using MRT in the UK as of July 2025. This has been used in clinical research in the United States to treat cardiac-compromised newborns. MRT originated as a special form of in vitro fertilisation in which some or all of the future baby's mitochondrial DNA (mtDNA) comes from a third party. This technique is used in cases when mothers carry genes for mitochondrial diseases. A second application is to use autologous mitochondria to replace mitochondria in damaged tissue to restore the tissue to a functional state. The male and female pronuclei are removed from each fertilized egg prior to their fusing, Mitochondrial replacement therapy (MRT), sometimes called mitochondrial donation, is the replacement of mitochondria in one or more cells to prevent or ameliorate disease. Naturally occurring hormones drive the cycles; the cyclical rise and fall of the follicle stimulating hormone prompts the production and growth of oocytes (immature egg cells). The hormone estrogen stimulates the uterus lining (endometrium) to thicken to accommodate an embryo should fertilization occur. The blood supply of the thickened lining provides nutrients to a successfully implanted embryo. If implantation does not occur, the lining breaks down and blood is released. Menstrual cycle These cycles are concurrent and coordinated, normally last between 21 and 35 days, with a median length of 28 days. an unfertilized egg disintegrates or dissolves in the fallopian tube, and a fertilized egg reaches the uterus in three to five days. The ovarian cycle controls the production and release of eggs and the cyclic release of estrogen and

progesterone. Menarche (the onset of the first period) usually occurs around the age of 12 years; menstrual cycles continue for about 30–45 years. Fertilization usually The menstrual cycle is a series of natural changes in hormone production and the structures of the uterus and ovaries of the female reproductive system that makes pregnancy possible. The uterine cycle governs the preparation and maintenance of the lining of the uterus (womb) to receive an embryo 329c4d4432

This process was first introduced in Spain in 2007 at the CEFER institute. 329c4d4432 There are several differences between classic IVF and ICSI. However, the steps to be followed before and after insemination are the same. In terms of insemination, ICSI needs only one sperm cell per oocyte, while IVF needs 50,000–100,000. Yury Verlinsky He is best known as a pioneer in prenatal diagnosis for detecting genetic and chromosomal disorders six weeks earlier than standard amniocentesis. It is now accepted worldwide as the standard for the most efficient and effective means of analyzing the chromosomal status of an embryo. He later found that a single cell could be removed from an early fertilized egg without disturbing subsequent development, and it can then be used Yury Verlinsky (1 September 1943 – 16 July 2009) was a Russian-American medical researcher specializing in embryonic and cellular genetics (genetic cytology). pregnancies. The founding father of pre-implantation genetic diagnosis (PGD) and embryo analysis prior to in-vitro fertilization (IVF), Verlinsky used his polar body biopsy technique to detect potential birth defects in offspring 329c4d4432
