The same amount of water vapor results in higher relative humidity in cool air than warm air. A related parameter is the dew point. The amount of water vapor needed to achieve saturation increases as the temperature increases. As the temperature of a parcel of air decreases it will eventually reach the saturation point without adding or losing water mass. The amount of water vapor contained within a parcel of air can vary significantly. January-February 2019 North American cold wave In early March, the cold once again shifted east, breaking records in many areas. attributed the unusual weather pattern to climate change. As a result, February 2019 was among the coldest and snowiest on record in these regions. In early February, a concentration of Arctic air colloquially referred to as the "polar vortex" moved west, and became locked over Western Canada and the Western United States. It came after a winter storm brought up to 13 inches (33 cm) of snow in some regions from January 27-29, and brought the lowest temperatures in over 20 years to most locations in the affected region, including some all-time record lows. At least 22 deaths in North America have been directly attributed to the cold wave, with several In late January 2019, a severe cold wave caused by a weakened jet stream around the Arctic polar vortex hit the Midwestern United States and Eastern Canada, killing at least 22 people. In mid-March, the cold wave finally retreated, but combined with above-average temperatures, precipitation, and a deep snowpack, widespread flooding ensued in the Central US b587186258
