In 1985 they released and started to manufacture the first in their line of home pregnancy test kits marketed under the Clearblue brand. The name is related to the fact that the test produced a blue marker line as a positive (pregnant) result and that it is 'clear' and simple to use. Luteinizing hormone The production of LH is regulated by gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH) from the hypothalamus. It acts synergistically with follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH). In females, an acute rise of LH known as an LH surge, triggers ovulation and development of the corpus luteum. (egg) has been discharged. The corpus luteum is so named because it often has a distinctive yellow color.
