It can develop either directly from exposure to Y.

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pestis or as a complication of untreated bubonic plague. In the case of primary infection, *Y. pestis* bacteria enter the skin after a flea bite and travel throughout the bloodstream, showing no localizing signs of infection. This makes diagnosis difficult, as plague is generally rare and initial symptoms resemble several other, more common... 85454cf599

Yersinia pestis is a facultative anaerobic parasitic bacterium that can infect humans primarily via its host, the oriental rat flea (*Xenopsylla cheopis*), but also through aerosols and airborne droplets for its pneumonic form. on

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prairie food webs. *pestis*; formerly *Pasteurella pestis*) is a gram-negative, non-motile, coccobacillus bacterium without spores. It is related to pathogens *Yersinia enterocolitica*, and *Yersinia pseudotuberculosis*, from which it evolved. *Y. pestis* is a hyperparasite. Flea Their claws keep them from being dislodged, and their mouthparts are adapted for piercing skin and sucking blood. Adult fleas grow to about 3 millimetres (1/8 inch) long Flea, the common name for the order Siphonaptera, includes 2,500 species of small flightless insects that live as external parasites of mammals and birds. They

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lack wings; their hind legs are extremely well adapted for jumping. Fleas live by ingesting the blood of their hosts. Some species can leap 50 times their body length, a feat second only to jumps made by another group of insects, the superfamily of froghoppers. Flea larvae are worm-like, with no limbs; they have chewing mouthparts and feed on organic debris left on their hosts' skin. Adult fleas grow to about 3 millimetres (1/8 inch) long, are usually dark in color, and have bodies that are "flattened" sideways or narrow, enabling them to move through their hosts' fur or feathers. as external parasites of mammals and birds. Tungiasis causes skin inflammation, severe pain, itching, and a lesion at the site of infection that is characterized by a black dot at the center of a swollen red lesion, surrounded by what looks like a white halo. Nitenpyram Nitenpyram is highly selective towards the variation of the nAChR which insects possess, and has seen extensive use in targeted, insecticide applications. The compound is an insect neurotoxin belonging to the class of neonicotinoids which works by blocking neural signaling of the central nervous system. It does so by binding irreversibly to the nicotinic acetylcholine receptor (nAChR) causing a stop of the flow of ions in the postsynaptic membrane of neurons leading to paralysis and death. A study showed that six hours after application the infestation of fleas on decreased by 96. 7% for dogs and 95 Nitenpyram is a chemical frequently used as an insecticide in agriculture and veterinary medicine. first fleas dislodge from the pet host 85454cf599

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Genetic evidence indicates that fleas are a specialised lineage of parasitic scorpionflies (Mecoptera) sensu lato, most closely related to the family Nannochoristidae. The earliest known fleas lived in the Middle Jurassic; modern-looking forms appeared in the Cenozoic. Fleas probably originated on mammals first and expanded their reach to... 85454cf599

Septicemic plague As the disease progresses, disseminated intravascular coagulation causes internal and external bleeding, gangrene, and shock. Septicemic plague is a systemic disease in which *Y. pestis* bites from infected fleas. However Septicemic plague is one of three types of plague caused by *Yersinia pestis*, a gram-negative species of bacterium. Left untreated, septicemic plague is almost always fatal, sometimes within hours of initial symptoms. These cats and dogs could then expose humans to the plague when the animal brings those infected fleas around people. It is one of three forms of plague, along with bubonic (affecting the lymph nodes) and pneumonic (affecting the lungs) plagues. *pestis* rapidly infects the bloodstream, initially causing nonspecific symptoms including fever, chills, malaise, abdominal pain, diarrhea, and vomiting 85454cf599

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
