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The first stage, the cephalic phase of digestion, begins with secretions from gastric glands in response to the sight and smell of food, and continues in the mouth with the mechanical breakdown of food by chewing, and the chemical breakdown by digestive enzymes in the saliva. Saliva contains amylase, and lingual lipase, secreted by the salivary glands, and serous glands on the tongue.

Chewing mixes the food with saliva to produce a food bolus to be swallowed down the esophagus to enter the stomach. The second stage, the gastric phase, takes place in the stomach, where the food is further broken down by mixing with gastric juice until it passes into the duodenum, the first part of the small intestine. The intestinal phase where the partially digested food is mixed with pancreatic...
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Gastrointestinal tract the intestinal wall. 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Following removal of the bowel segment(s), either continuity of the bowel is restored with an anastomosis or an intestinal diversion is created through an ostomy. When parts of the colon remain, typically a colostomy is created whereas a total colectomy requires an ileostomy. Complications of...
The diagnosis of appendicitis is largely based on the person... Renal is Latin for "kidney", while nephro is the Greek equivalent. Lithiasis (Greek) and calculus (Latin; plural calculi) both mean stone. Hence, kidney stones are sometimes known as renal calculi or nephroliths, and the condition may be known as nephrolithiasis.

Diverticulitis Fever or blood in the stool suggests a complication. People may experience a single attack, repeated attacks, or ongoing "smoldering" diverticulitis. There may also be nausea, diarrhea or constipation. Diverticulitis, also called colonic diverticulitis, is a gastrointestinal disease characterized by inflammation of abnormal pouches—diverticula—that can develop in the wall of the large intestine. Symptoms typically include lower abdominal pain of sudden onset, but the onset may also occur over a few days

Appendicitis is primarily caused by a blockage of the hollow portion in the appendix. This blockage typically results from a faecolith, a calcified "stone" made of feces. Some studies show a correlation between appendicoliths and disease severity. Other factors such as inflamed lymphoid tissue from a viral infection, intestinal parasites, gallstone, or tumors may also lead to this blockage. When the appendix becomes blocked, it experiences increased pressure, reduced blood flow, and bacterial growth, resulting in inflammation. This combination of factors causes tissue injury and, ultimately, tissue death. If this process is left untreated, it can lead to the appendix rupturing, which releases bacteria into the abdominal cavity, potentially leading to severe complications.

Low-fiber/low-residue diet While a low-fiber diet is generally used for acute diverticulitis, the NIH guidelines recommend a high-fiber diet for patients. A low-residue diet is a diet which aims to reduce the amount of residue, which is the indigestible material remaining in the large intestine after digestion of food. for the effectiveness of this. Since this residue contributes to fecal bulking, a low-residue diet in theory reduces the quantity of feces and frequency of defecation

Most animals have a "through-gut" or complete digestive tract. Exceptions are more primitive ones: sponges have small pores (ostia) throughout their body for digestion and a larger dorsal pore (osculum) for excretion, comb jellies have both a ventral mouth and dorsal anal pores, while cnidarians and acoels have a single pore for both digestion and excretion. bd944c847f The human gastrointestinal tract consists of the esophagus, stomach, and intestines, and is divided into the upper and lower gastrointestinal tracts. Kidney stone disease About half of all people who have had a kidney stone are likely to develop another within ten years. Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough they may pass out of the urinary tract through the urine stream. Pain in the lower-left quadrant can sometimes be confused with diverticulitis because the sigmoid colon overlaps the ureter, and the exact location Kidney stone disease or urinary stone disease is a crystallopathy that occurs when there is an excess of minerals in the urine and not enough liquid or hydration. A small calculus may pass without causing any symptoms. A calculus may also result in blood in the urine, vomiting (owing to severe pain), swelling of the kidney, or painful urination. However, if a stone grows to more than 5 millimeters (0. 2 inches), it can cause blockage of the ureter, resulting in extremely sharp and severe pain (renal colic) in the lower back that often radiates to the groin. This imbalance causes tiny crystals to aggregate and form hard masses, or calculi (stones), in the upper urinary tract. ureters bd944c847f

Most often the diet is used as part of bowel preparation before colonoscopy. The low-residue diet is not

usually intended to be a long term diet. It may also be used as a short-term therapy for acute stages of gastrointestinal illnesses such as Crohn's disease, diverticulitis, bowel obstruction, and ulcerative colitis. In addition, a low-residue diet is often prescribed before and/or after abdominal surgery or cancer treatments.

In standard medicine, the most frequent uses of enemas are to relieve constipation and for bowel cleansing before a medical examination or procedure; also, they are employed as a lower gastrointestinal series (also called a barium enema), to treat traveler's diarrhea, as a vehicle for the administration of food, water or medicine, as a stimulant to the general system, as a local application and, more rarely, as a means of reducing body temperature, as treatment for encopresis, and as a form of rehydration therapy (proctoclysis) in patients for whom intravenous therapy is not applicable.

Colectomy may be performed for prophylactic, curative, or palliative reasons. Indications include inflammatory/autoimmune, cancer/precancer, vascular/ischemic, mechanical, infectious, traumatic, and functional. Most colectomies are elective; however conditions such as perforation, necrosis (transmural or otherwise), uncontrolled hemorrhage, or obstruction with imminent perforation require emergency surgery. Colectomy is performed either as an open surgery requiring a large incision or minimally invasive which includes standard laparoscopic and robot-assisted laparoscopic.

The causes of diverticulitis are unclear. Risk factors may include obesity, lack of exercise, smoking, a family history of the disease, and use of nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). The role of a low fiber diet as a risk factor is unclear. Having pouches in the large intestine that are not inflamed is known as diverticulosis. Inflammation occurs in 10% and 25% at some point in time and is due to a bacterial infection. Diagnosis is typically by CT scan. However, blood tests, colonoscopy, or a lower gastrointestinal series may also be supportive. The differential diagnoses include irritable bowel syndrome.

Human feces have similarities to the feces of other animals and varies significantly in appearance (i.e. size, color, texture), according to the state of the diet, digestive system, and general health. Appendicitis Severe complications of a ruptured appendix include widespread, painful inflammation of the inner lining of the abdominal wall and sepsis. However, approximately 40% of people do not have these typical symptoms. Symptoms commonly include right lower abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, fever and decreased appetite.
